Rehearsals

With only three Thursday rehearsals left until showtime, we are trying to maximize as much rehearsal time as possible. This is to ensure that we have enough time to do a complete run through of the show before we perform to a paying audience!

Costumes

Please see below for a list of the costumes required. Please could all costumes be in school by Monday 15 May 2017. Costumes should be in a named carrier bag and put in the costume box in the spare Y3 classroom. All children will need a pair of black lightweight shoes – either plimsolls, jazz shoes or ballet pumps as this reduces the noise when the children are on stage. If your child is playing two parts, they will need a costume for each part.
