Dear Parents/Carers,

Music Evening 2017

This year Stamford Green's Music Evening will be held on **Wednesday 8 February** at 6.30pm. Any pupil who plays a musical instrument is invited to sign up on the sheet outside Mrs Glaister's (2G) door no later than **Friday 27 January 2017**. Children will need to write what instrument they will be playing alongside their name and class. All children that write their names down will be included in Music Evening – no auditions are taking place. I have spoken to all the children in a recent assembly so they should know all about the event!

The children will need to bring in their instruments and sheet music to school on **1 February** for a quick run-through as well as performing to the whole school in a 'dress rehearsal' on **6 February** at 1.30pm.

As always, we welcome all parents, family and friends to come and watch your child perform and enjoy Music Evening with us. Children performing will need to be at school by 6.00pm. They will need to be looking smart in their school uniform and are allowed to bring a light snack and water bottle with them (no sweets, chocolate or sugary drinks please). On arrival, the children will meet in 2G (Mrs Glaister's classroom).

We can look forward to some wonderful solo pieces and duets as well as hearing from the School Choir and the Y2/Y3 singing club who do not need to prepare anything and need to arrive at the same time as the musicians. Mrs James and Mrs Sayers will be preparing a couple of songs each for the children to perform.

On the day of Music Evening, the children can leave their instruments in their classroom and bring them to 2G after school. Please ensure your child also has any other necessary bits and pieces such as spare reeds, foot-stools or straps!

Family and friends should arrive at 6.15pm so that the evening can begin promptly at 6.30pm. Entrance and exit for the evening will be via the school entrance by the Office. Unfortunately the West Gate will not be open. The PTA will be running a bar in the hall/club room where refreshments will be available to purchase before the performance and during the interval.

During the interval, children in YR, Y1 and Y2 may leave to go home if they are feeling sleepy. Their performances will take place in the first half.
