Are you aware that the PTA operates a 100 Club? It is a great way for parents, relatives and friends to help raise much needed funds to support the school through the PTA's Strategy (see website), where the longer term goal is to enrich, renovate and relocate the school library.

For the cost of £1.00 per month (payable as an annual amount by cash or cheque until April 2018), your number will be entered into the draw for a cash prize of 50% of the monthly prize fund.

Members may be any person over 18 with a connection to the school. There is no limit to the number of members per household, and each member may purchase up to a maximum of 5 numbers.

The draws take place on the last Friday of the month, during assembly. The April draw will be done in the first assembly on a Friday in May. The earlier you buy your numbers, the more draws you can be included in.

To take part, all you have to do is to fill in the attached form and send in your payment of £1 per month until April 2018 (per number purchased). Please note that there is an opportunity to select your lucky numbers if they are available so get in quick! If your lucky numbers have already been allocated (on a first come first served basis) then numbers will be allocated randomly.

Each month the winning number will be published in the school newsletter and on the PTA's Facebook page. The cash prize can be collected from the school office. Any prize money that is not collected within 3 months will be donated to the PTA.

Stamford Green Primary School PTA 100 Club Rules

Aims

- The purpose of the 100 club is to raise money for the PTA who support projects to enrich school life for the children.
- All money raised will go into the PTA bank account and will be used to fund extra resources, activities and opportunities for the children.
- The more people who join the club, the more money the school will receive, and the higher the prize values.

Rules

1. For a cost of £1.00 per month (i.e. per draw), payable as £12.00 annually, a member is allocated a number. Payments of £12.00 must be made by cash/cheque and will be paid into the PTA's bank account. Only numbers that are fully paid will be entered into the draw. There is an opportunity for members to select their lucky numbers on a first come first served basis. If your lucky numbers have already been allocated (on a first come first served basis) then numbers will be allocated randomly.
2. The club runs for twelve months starting in April 2016. A payment of £12.00 entitles the member of the club to be entered into all draws for the rest of the year, i.e. if you enter part-way through the year, you will be entered into all the remaining draws for that year. The earlier you enter the more draws you are entered for.
3. A minimum of 20 members is required. A list of all members in the 100 club will be kept by a nominated member of the PTA and a copy kept in the school office.
4. A draw will be made every month with a single prize of 50% of the monthly money received for the 100 Club. The prize money will be reviewed on at least a six-monthly basis. The PTA may at its discretion increase (or decrease) the amount of prize money and/or the number of prizes awarded every month, depending on the amount of members in the club.
5. Participants must be over 18 but may be any person with a connection to the school.
6. There is no limit to the number of entrants per household, but no individual may purchase more than 5 numbers per year.
7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
8. The draw shall be made by a member of the Leadership Team during an assembly. The first draw will take place on Friday 29.4.16 during assembly and subsequent draws will be done on the last Friday assembly of the month. The August draw will be done in the first assembly on a Friday in September.
9. The prize money is to be collected by the winner from the school office. Prize money that remains uncollected for 3 months shall be repaid to the PTA 100 club fund.
10. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the PTA Facebook page and in the school Newsletter.
11. The 100 Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
