Dear Parents/Carers,

Quiz Club – Inter School Quiz Championship

An opportunity has arisen for me to take a team, comprising of one child from each year group from Y3 to Y6, to go to The Vale Primary school on Wednesday 19 April to take part in a quiz with children from other local schools.

Your child scored the highest mark in their year group (if two children scored the same, then a name was picked as part of a lucky dip) and has been selected to be a part of the quiz team. I would be grateful if you could transport your child to The Vale Primary School for 1.45pm. There are supporter seats so you are more than welcome to come and watch the quiz too. We will be leaving The Vale at 3.00pm but just in case we get held up the Office will look after any siblings until we arrive back at school and you can collect them.

On the day....

Each team of 4 is sat at their own named table, with each player using their personal wireless handset to answer questions. When the children arrive in the hall, they are seated at their table with year 5 and 6 team members at either end of the table and year 3 & 4 team members in the middle (ensuring the younger team members have the benefit of having the older children seated at either side of them). The Quizmaster takes some time to speak to the teams and explain how to use the handsets and some basic strategy for playing the quiz, putting the children at ease and answering any of their questions. The team is encouraged to discuss and confer on their answers before making their selection, although ultimately each player makes their own decision as to which answer they would like to select.

The quiz is projected to a very large screen, so all team members and the audience is able to see every question, the four possible answers and the teams' scores throughout. The questions vary in point value and difficulty level and cover a wide selection of subjects. Many questions also include pictures and music. The teams have 30 seconds to answer each question. There are two rounds to the quiz – the first round comprises 30 questions and the second round comprises 10 questions. Throughout the quiz, the Quizmaster will keep an eye on all of the teams and continue to encourage them to confer on their answers.
