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### Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 10.7.17

In English this week we are looking at Instruction writing. We will be linking our writing to our themed learning "Sensational World" which is related to the five senses. Before writing instructions we will be making some foods which we will evaluate using our senses. We will then write instructions as to how to make them.

### Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 10.7.17

In English this week, we will be continuing our iPad projects – creating an animal encyclopaedia! They are already coming along beautifully and the children can't wait to print off their final books next week!

In maths, we will be re-capping on addition and subtraction through the method of column addition and subtraction. This will be in its very basic form with no carrying or exchange. See method below.

Children add two 2-digit numbers using column addition. No carrying.	$\begin{array}{r} 24 \\ +43 \\ \hline 67 \end{array}$
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Children subtract two 2-digit numbers using column subtraction. No 'borrowing'.	$\begin{array}{r} 45 \\ -23 \\ \hline 22 \end{array}$
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Coming up soon in speedy maths (\* indicates new learning):

w/c 10.7.17	Know 2x, 5x, 10x tables and division facts at speed Know addition and subtraction facts to 20 Add and subtract 1-digit and 2-digit numbers Know pairs of numbers to 10, 20, 30, 40 and pairs of tens to 100.
w/c 17.7.17	Add and subtract tens and 2-digit numbers Count in 2s from any number Know 2x, 5x, 10x tables and division facts at speed Know 1,2, &10 more and 1, 2 & 10 less at speed

### Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 10.7.17

In English this week, the children are continuing their story writing work inspired by the book 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. The whole of the story is told using only pictures. This week, the children will be using their drafts from last week to start making their own book.

In maths, the children will be starting the week working with measuring liquids. Later in the week they are going to be tackling some maths investigations that involve data handling and time.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

w/b 10.7.17	To say 100 less than numbers to 3-digit. To say 100 more than numbers to 3-digit. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and division facts. Know pairs of numbers to 20.
w/b 17.7.17	To add hundreds to 3-digit numbers at speed. To say 100 more than and less than numbers to 3-digit. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and division facts. To x and ÷ any number by 10. Know pairs of tens to 100.

Outside of English and Maths, the children will be learning more about aspects of the Sikh faith, following our trip to the Sikh Gurdwara earlier in the year. They will find out about the Gurus of Sikhism and about how the religion began. The children will also learn about the 5 Ks and about some Sikh ceremonies.

We hope those of you who could make it enjoyed the children's dance performance at the Summer Fun Day. It was lovely to see many of you there and we were both very proud of the children.

Next Wednesday (19.7.17), the children will be having their class parties in the afternoon. They do not require a change of clothes. As a year group, they have discussed what would make a good party for them. As a result, the children will come home this week with a note in their Learning Journals with what they have volunteered to bring to the party.

As 3S won the Jam Jar competition this year (whoop whoop!), their prize is extra play in the form of a class water fight. This will happen on Thursday 13 July. Your child will need a change of clothes and any water guns/balloons they have.

#### Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 10.7.17

In English this week, we will be using everything we have learnt this year to write a short extract from a story about being stranded on a desert island. We will also be having a spelling test on the Year 4 words and continuing to work on verbs in the present perfect tense and simple past tense.

In maths we will be completing our final summary of learning to show how much we have learnt over the year.

Coming up in speedy maths (\* indicates new learning):

w/b 10.7.17	Use tables to work out related $\times$ and $\div$ at speed. Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 100. Give change from £1 at speed
17.7.17	Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Use tables facts to work out related $\times$ at speed.

In science we will be researching about how environments can change and how this can sometimes pose dangers for living things. In DT we will be making torches. We will be looking at different torch designs and exploring what makes an effective torch. After completing our research, we will then be making our own torches. **If you have a different kind of torch at home e.g. lantern, wind up torch that we could look at, it would be really helpful if these could be brought into school before Thursday.**

Tomorrow, the children will be moving to their new class for the day to meet their new teacher. We are sure they will be excited to tell you all about their experience when they get home.

Next week our class party will be held in the afternoon on Wednesday 19 July. There is no need for children to bring a change of clothes. We would be grateful for a food contribution and will put stickers in the Learning Journals this week so that we do not get too much of one item!

Please note that you only to supply enough food for one table (6 people) and not the whole class. Thank you in advance for your generosity.
