Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 12.6.17

In English this week we will be reading Horrid Henry by Francesca Simon. We will be writing character descriptions using adjectives and correct punctuation and we will be planning and writing our own versions of the story with an emphasis on producing a longer piece of writing.

We will be finding halves and doubles of numbers and quantities. If you would like to help your child practise, there are lots of real life examples of halving when sharing things between two people (how many strawberries will we each get?); or of doubling when we buy a double quantity (If there are 4 Magnums in 1 box, how many in 2 boxes?). We will also be practising our addition and subtraction skills.

Please could you ensure that your child's PE kit has come back to school.

Remember to keep practising all the Year 1 Spelling Words with particular emphasis on the ones your child wasn't sure of in the end of half term tests (in the back of their Learning Journal). They will be tested on all 100 towards the end of term.

The children will be completing the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check with their teacher this week. This will involve each child reading a mixture of words. We have completed similar activities plenty of times through the year, so it should not seem to be out of the ordinary for the children.

On Wednesday 5 July Year 1 will be visiting the British Wildlife Centre. If you are able to help on the trip please can you email Mrs Williams ASAP. The trip will be all day. Many thanks in advance. williamse@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk

Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 12.6.17

In English this week, we will be beginning some work based upon the Peter Rabbit stories by Beatrix Potter. Over the coming weeks, the children will be experimenting with different styles of writing linked with some of these stories including character descriptions, using the 4 different sentence types, non-chronological reports, letters and lots more! This week we will be exploring the tales of Peter Rabbit and Benjamin Rabbit.

In maths over the next few weeks the children will be demonstrating their maths knowledge through a range of mini tasks. Some of the aspects of maths we will be revisiting include adding two 2 digit numbers, subtracting two 2 digit numbers, rounding, estimating and splitting 2 digit numbers into their tens and ones in different ways.

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 12.6.17

In English this week, the children are going to be working on writing recounts of an event. We are going to think about what the appropriate amount of detail is to include in the main body of our work and will be perfecting how to write good introductions and conclusions.

In maths this week, we are working with measures. The children will be converting between mm, cm and m as well as revising their practical measuring skills. Later in the week, they will focus on measuring and calculating perimeters of different shapes.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

w/b 12.6.17	To say 100 more than and less than numbers to 3-digit. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and division facts. To x and ÷ any number by 10 Know pairs of tens to 100.
w/b 19.6.17	Subtract tens from 3-digit numbers at speed. Add tens to 3-digit numbers at speed. To multiply and divide any number by 10 at speed. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and division facts.

We will be continuing our preparations for dancing at the Summer Fun Day by practising our traditional dancing. The Summer Fun Day will be held on **Saturday 8.7.16** and the children will be performing a selection of traditional dances. We will update you soon with specific timings of when the children are due to perform. Coming up in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 19.6.17	Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Convert cm to mm and vice versa Add three tens at speed. Continue simple number patterns

In our themed learning, we will be continuing our investigation 'Is sugar bad for your teeth?' and recording our observations and findings.

Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 12.6.17

In English this week we will focusing on non-fiction writing. Children will be learning about the editing process and how final versions might differ from previous drafts. They will also look at presentation and the importance of ensuring that final versions are neatly presented.

In maths children will be looking at Roman Numerals. They will practise reading and writing Roman Numerals. They will also explore different number systems and why they were invented. Later in the week, children will be investigating. They will consider different approaches before deciding how best to tackle given problems.

Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 12.6.17

This week, we will be visited by Rosebery and Nonsuch (Monday), Blenheim (Tuesday) and Glyn (Wednesday) as part of the children's transition to secondary. The children will spend time with teachers from their chosen school and have an opportunity to ask questions.
