Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 19.6.17

In English this week we will be continuing to listen to Horrid Henry stories and we will be focusing on re-writing stories and writing our own versions. This will mean writing longer pieces of and thinking carefully about capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. The children will also be using a range of interesting vocabulary to make their writing interesting.

Our main focus this week in Maths is some practical activities that focus on multiplication and division in a real-life context. We will also bring some open ended investigations and learning how to record our ideas. We will be focusing on sharing and grouping. We will also be rehearsing some of our basic maths skills.

Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 19.6.17

In English this week, we will be continuing our writing based upon the Peter Rabbit stories by Beatrix Potter. This week we will look at the story of Jemima Puddleduck – the children will be writing questions to task 'Jemima' and answering them as if they were her! At the end of the week we will be writing about our zoo trip.

In maths, we will focus on inverse – both addition and subtraction then multiplication and division, fractions of shapes and finding different ways of making the same money amount. If you get chance to get some coins out at home, it would be great to practise this with your child.

Coming up soon in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/c 19.6.17	*Know pairs of numbers to 40 Add 10 to any number Know 2x, 5x, 10x table Count in 1s, 2s, 3s, 5s, 10s, $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s
w/c 26.6.17	*Add tens to 2-digit numbers Know 10 more or 10 less than 2-digit number Know addition facts to 20

Add 1-digit to 2-digit numbers Know subtraction facts to 20 Subtract 1-digit from 2-digit numbers Know 2x, 5x, 10x tables and division facts

We are getting excited about our trip to Drusillas Zoo on Thursday, and provided the weather continues to be hot and dry we are considering letting the children have a play in the water playground just before we leave to come back to school, to help cool down!

With this in mind, in addition to having applied suncream before school and providing a sun hat, please pack a small rucksack (which your child won't mind carrying around all day) with:

- a filled-up water bottle
- a change of top, bottoms and underwear (not necessarily school uniform) in a carrier bag
- a dry flannel to help dry off after the water play

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 19.6.17

In English this week, the children will be looking at different forms of poetry and considering how to use words effectively. We will particularly be looking at cinquains, a five-lined poem with a given syllable structure, and shape poems.

In maths, the children will be doing some large scale measuring. Later in the week, we will be analysing data collected from the school's mock general election and using it to draw graphs.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

w/b 19.6.17	Subtract tens from 3-digit numbers at speed. Add tens to 3-digit numbers at speed. To multiply and divide any number by 10 at speed. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and division facts.
w/b 26.6.17	To say 100 more than numbers to 3-digit. Subtract tens from 3-digit numbers at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 100. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and division facts.

In our themed learning, the children will be learning about exploration after the Tudor period. We are going to be researching modern day explorers and also looking at the voyage of Charles Darwin. This will link in to our science work on animals.

We will be continuing our preparations for dancing at the Summer Fun Day by practising our traditional dancing. The Summer Fun Day will be held on **Saturday 8.7.17** and the children will be performing a selection of traditional dances. We will update you soon with specific timings of when the children are due to perform. At this stage, we need to know if your child cannot attend the Summer Fun Day so that we can arrange positions for the dances. If you know that your child will not be able to attend this event, please email Mrs Smith (see below). Nearer the time, we will give further details regarding where and when we will meet on the day. If you

Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 19.6.17

We hope you all enjoyed hearing about High Ashurst from your children and following our photos on Twitter. We have also heard from Mrs Spooner who said that her operation went well and she would like to say a massive thank you for all the kind words, cards and gifts she received. She was quite overwhelmed.

In English this week, we will be writing a recount of our High Ashurst residential. We will also be looking at our Year Group book, 'Kensuke's Kingdom' and using dictionaries to expand our vocabulary.

In maths we will be using bar models to solve division, multiplication and fraction problems. We will also be undertaking an investigation based on rules for games and learning how to work systematically to solve problems.

Coming up in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 20.6.16	Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Convert cm to mm and vice versa Add three tens at speed. Continue simple number patterns
w/b 27.6.16	*Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 100. Add 3 1-digit numbers at speed. Use tables facts to work out related x at speed.

In our themed learning we will be writing up our results from our, 'Is sugar bad for your teeth?' investigation and learning all about digestion. In art we will be painting our High Ashurst tiles, focusing on colour mixing and accuracy.

We look forward to welcoming you to the Year 4 lunch with parents this Wednesday 21 June. Just a reminder that we are still collecting empty tubes such as kitchen rolls – no toilet rolls please!

Whilst Mrs Peters is away with Y6 on their residential trip, 4S are being taught by Ms Featherstone, who will be working closely with Miss Jenkins to ensure it is learning as usual for 4S.

Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 19.6.17

In English this week we will be focusing on reviews. Children will be looking at a variety of reviews and will be considering their effectiveness. They will also be considering whether the reviews are balanced. After watching extracts from the London 2012 Olympic Opening Ceremony, children will be writing their own detailed reviews.

In maths children will be learning about basic economics related to our lolly selling enterprise. They will explore concepts such as revenue, profit and cost. Later in the week they will also undertake an investigation requiring logical thought and exploration of number.
