This week we are combining our English and RE lessons to learn about the Easter story and why Easter is celebrated by Christians. We will also be thinking about the Easter symbols, such as Easter eggs and how these relate to the Easter story.

As it is the last week of term 1W, 1R and 1S will be having Show and Tell time on Thursday. As ever, please ensure that any items coming into school are clearly name labelled. Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 27.3.17

In English this week, will be continuing to explore Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will be developing our imaginative description and how we describe characters' feelings. As the week continues, we will be writing diary entries as Charlie Bucket at different parts of the story.

In maths we will be spending the week investigating the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. We will be finding examples of these shapes which exist all around us and will be learning how to describe and sort these shapes using the correct mathematical vocabulary e.g. faces, edges, vertices, apex etc. Towards the end of the week, the children will be consolidating their learning from this half term in their summary of learning.

Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 27.3.17

We are very lucky to have been invited to a showing of the play 'In the Net' about safe internet use, which is specifically targeted at Year 4 pupils. The play will be shown to a number of schools at Epsom Primary School on Wednesday 19 April (the second day back at school after the Easter Holidays). We need some parent volunteers to help us walk to and from Epsom Primary School and would be really grateful for your help. We will leave Stamford Green at 9.15am and will be back at school around 11.30am. In RE we are looking at the significance of Lent for Christians and the Easter story, with a particular focus on how Christians prepare for Easter in different ways.

In English this week we will be looking at the features of persuasive writing and how these were used in the propaganda posters of WW2. The children will be designing their own posters later in the week.

In maths this week, the children will be using their problem solving skills to tackle an open ended problem. They will also be learning all about Roman Numerals and using their knowledge to solve some calculations written in Roman Numerals.

In our themed learning this week we will be learning about the significant battles that made up WW2. The children will be working in groups and will present their work at the end of the week.

Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 27.3.17
