Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 3.7.17

In maths this week we will be learning about measures including capacity and, as mentioned last week, we will be using water to investigate. We will be thinking about how much liquid containers can hold and start to think about litres and millilitres.

In English this week, the children will be writing a recount of their school trip. They will be focusing on including as much detail as possible and correct punctuation.

This week the children will be learning about similarities and differences. This will include watching Y1's RSE (Relationship and Sex Education) DVD as part of our study of animals in general. The focus for us is Similarities and Differences and it includes the difference between boys and girls including naming external genitalia (penis, testicles and vulva). We use the same DVD that the children saw in Reception as part of this.

A reminder about our exciting trip to The British Wildlife Centre on Wednesday 5 July: Children must wear school uniform. Given the changeable weather of the past few weeks, both a

waterproof jacket or a sunhat will also be needed. If they are not needed during the day we will keep them together so please make sure they are labelled to make it easy for us to hand out again at the end. In the case of hot weather please ensure your child is wearing sun protection cream when they come to school.

The children will need a packed lunch. If your child usually has a school meal on a Monday it will be provided by the school kitchen (unless you have already informed us differently). If you wish to send additional snacks to supplement the lunch then you are most welcome but please respect that we are a nut-free school. Please be aware we will leave at approximately 9.15am and we should be back at school by 3.05pm, although this is dependent on traffic.

Last but not least, a big thank you to our wonderful volunteers without whom we could not safely run the trip.

Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 3.7.17

In English this week, we will be beginning a project using the iPads which will link the children's learning on information texts, animals and their habitats as well as a range of computing objectives from the curriculum map. The children will be creating electronic books using the Book Creator app, adding pictures from search engines and adding in their own information. This project will continue over the next 3 weeks as the children compile their animal encyclopaedias.

In maths, we will be focussing on shape. The children will be revising the names of 2D shapes as well as their properties. We aim to be more confident in our use of the terms edges, vertices and faces and use these terms to describe the properties of these shapes.

Next week we will be rounding off our themed learning by making habitat boxes. The children will need a shoe box or similar sized cereal box for this task. Please bring in on Monday 10 July. Thanks for your help with this.

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 3.7.17

In English this week, the children are beginning a project to create their own story books. 10.7.17	* Use tables to work out related x and ÷ at speed. Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 100. Give change from £1 at speed

In science we will be continuing to learn about classification. We will be exploring and using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in the local environment. In music we will be using our knowledge about different note lengths to write our own compositions to play to each other. The famous Year 6 vs. teachers' rounder match will also be taking place this week.

Next week the children will complete their last maths summary of learning and spelling test of the Year 4 spelling words. Please help your child to practise these words in preparation.

This week, we will be watching and discussing the RSE video on Monday. For those of you who didn't make it to our meeting last Thursday, this deals with issues around puberty, body image and the media.

As part of our themed learning, 'Healthy bodies, healthy minds', we have designed a healthy snack for Year R. The children have worked in groups to agree and adapt a recipe and share the responsibility for bringing in the ingredients and equipment. This has been written in their Learning Journals.
