**Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 31.10.16**

Due to the popularity of Julia Donaldson's stories we are pleased to say that we will continue to look at her books this week. During our English lessons we will be thinking about how to describe the characters in the Julia Donaldson books and we will be writing our own description of a Julia Donaldson character. We will also be sharing the many Julia Donaldson books that the children have brought in from home.

In maths, we are continuing to practise addition using practical apparatus for buying toys from the 'toy shop'. We will also be beginning to look at measuring and ordering objects by size. The children seem to be really enjoying their daily speedy maths challenge. This week we are focussing on knowing the order of numbers at speed, with the children filling in missing numbers in number sequences.

This week we will be thinking about the special events that happen at this time of year – Fireworks Night; Remembrance Day and Diwali.

This week children will be bringing home the list of spelling words for this half term and these are the words we will be focusing on in "Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check". It is our aim that these are spelt correctly each time we use them in our own writing. The words for this half term are: dad, big, will, back, him, get, got, that, with, this, went, then, them, from, the, be, he, they, are, what.

As the weather gets colder, please could you remember to provide socks for PE if you have a daughter who wears tights to school and a blue school fleece that can remain in their PE bag.

### Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 31.10.16

Welcome back! We hope you all had a lovely half term break. We have a busy half term ahead of us with Victorian day, our visit to the mosque and rehearsals for our Christmas show all getting underway over the coming weeks! Watch this space for dates for our Victorian day coming soon. Please can we give a gentle reminder that permission and indication of parent help for our mosque trip must be made via Tucasi by Monday 14 November, so that we can arrange parent helpers and finalise our risk assessment – thank you in advance!

In English this week, we will be deepening our understanding of narrative texts. The children will continue to focus on the book 'The Man on the Moon' to deepen their understanding of descriptive language. The children will also be learning about suffixes and how to add these into their writing.

In maths, we will be beginning some work on fractions. The children will be working on mastering the concept of fractions as 'parts of a whole' this week and will be looking at representing various fractions using pictures, cubes, double-sided counters and eventually bar models. Ask your child what the following terms mean – vinculum, denominator, numerator and ask them to 'act it out'!

<b>w/b 7.11.16</b>	Know 2 x table at speed Add and subtract 1-digit from 2-digit at speed Know doubles of units at speed Count on in 5s at speed Know number bonds to 10 at speed

### Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 31.10.16

This week in English, we are exploring similes and alliteration in more detail by looking at, and writing our own, poetry. Our maths lessons this week are going to focus on problem solving, working systematically to find all the possibilities. One of the problems will need the children to use their column addition skills from earlier in the term to solve it.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

<b>w/b 31.10.16</b>	Add two tens at speed. Know 4x table at speed. Know 3x table at speed. Add and subtract 2-digit to 1-digit at speed.
<b>w/b 7.11.16</b>	Add two tens at speed. Know 3x and 4x tables at speed. Know 10 more and 10 less than 3 digit numbers.

In our themed learning, the children will be finishing off the model volcanoes they have been working on. We will then be thinking about the very beginnings of people by looking at and creating our own cave art. As previously mentioned, on Thursday afternoon (3.11.16) we are going to be doing a big cave art project. We would like to invite you to join your child for this activity from 2.10pm. If you do wish to join us, please arrive at the school office shortly before 2.10pm and we will meet you at the office.

### Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 31.10.16

We hope you had a lovely half term. It was great to welcome the children back and hear their news. Hopefully you enjoyed sharing your child's golden books with them. Please can you write a positive comment on the sticker and return them to school as soon as possible.

In English lessons this week, the children will be looking at autumn poems. They will be spotting poetic devices in the poems and using these to write their own autumn poems focusing on creating atmosphere.



In maths, the children will be focusing on multiplication. They will be using the grid method to multiply two digit and three digit numbers by one/two digit numbers.

Coming up soon in speedy maths (\* indicates new learning):

<b>w/b</b> <b>31.10.16</b>	*Give change from £1 at speed Know 8x table at speed Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Add and subtract tens with 3-digit numbers at speed. Know pairs of tens to 90
<b>w/b</b> <b>7.11.16</b>	*Know 11x table at speed Know 7x, 8x, 9x table at speed. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Give change from £1 at speed

Next week will be having an **Ancient Greek Day on Wednesday 9 November**. We would like the children to come to school dressed in Ancient Greek costume. If you are stuck for ideas some examples are, a Greek god or goddess, a mythical character, a civilian, a hero or a beast.

At the end of this half term we will be testing the children on the next 20 words in the Year 4 spelling list. Before learning any new words, it would be helpful to revise any words that your child did not spell correctly in the test at the end of last half term. These can be found towards the back of the Learning Journal. It is expected that the children will know all the Year 4 spellings by the end of the year. Your support with this matter is much appreciated.

### Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 31.10.16

Welcome back after half term - we hope you all had an enjoyable break!

In English we will be starting to consider Remembrance. We will also be looking at using apostrophes correctly and practising using extended sentences.

In maths children will continue to use the bar model method to interpret and analyse word problems. This is a way of representing problems visually that has been found to support the children in deciding how to go about solving them.

### Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 31.10.16

Welcome back – we hope you all had a lovely half term.

In English this week, we will be continuing to develop our reading skills – our ability to retrieve information and infer meaning – ensuring we fully explain and justify our responses. We will be using our knowledge of grammar and spelling to edit texts. In spelling this week, we will be looking at soft and hard ‘c’ and ‘g’ sounds, e.g. candle/cycle and game/giraffe.

In maths, we will be focusing on angles, revising the difference between acute, obtuse and reflex. We will be learning how to estimate and measure accurately as well as drawing angles using a protractor.

In speedy maths this week, we will be covering:

<b>w/b: 31.10.16</b>	Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Add and subtract p from £&p Know square roots to $\sqrt{144}$ (ie for tables) Use tables to work out related x and $\div$ at speed. Know number bonds to 1000 (tens)
<b>w/b: 7.10.16</b>	Know pairs of numbers to 100. Use tables to work out related x and $\div$ at speed. Know square numbers to $12^2$ Convert cm to mm and vice versa Convert m to km and vice versa Add and subtract 2-digit and 3-digit numbers at speed. Continue simple number patterns

In PE this week we will be continuing to develop our skills in football.

Please ensure that PE kits are in every day.
