Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 9.1.17

In Literacy, we are revisiting our work on poetry instead of having an 'author of the week.' The children will be reading a range of poems and creating their own versions using rhymes and similes. Can you help your child to spot pairs of rhyming words in their reading? Or challenge them to come up with a rhyme for any given word. If your child would like to bring in a poetry book to share, please ensure that it is clearly name-labelled.

Maths this week is continuing to look at subtraction. The children will be developing their understanding of number facts and practising applying subtraction to find solutions to problems.

In theme we will be learning about dates, in particular years and where and when our families were born. This will link to the sheets the children did at home over the Christmas holidays so if your child still needs to bring this in to school please could they do so in the next few days.

Mrs Williams is recovering and hopes to be back in class by the end of the week. Mrs James will continue to teach in 1W until she returns.

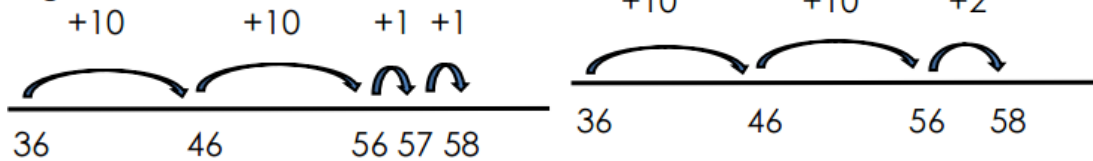
Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 9.1.17

In English we will be continuing our unit on poetry. We will review our understanding of alliteration and write poems using this. We will also be learning about shape poetry and creating our own. As part of our Grammar Hammer input we will learn about homophones (words that sound the same but are spelt differently), suffixes and conjunctions.

In maths, we will be continuing to work on addition. This week we will be introducing the children to ways of recording methods of addition – see teaching method below.

Use number grids and lines to add TU
+ TU by counting on in tens and ones.

e.g. $36 + 22 = 58$



Eventually moving onto recording the addition later in the week like this:

$$36 + 22 = 30 + 20 \text{ and } 6 + 2 = 58$$

Coming up soon in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 9.1.17	*Know 5x table at speed Know 2 x table at speed Know pairs of 10s to 100 Know 10 x table at speed Know number facts to 20 at speed Know doubles of units at speed
w/b 16.1.17	Know 5 x table at speed Count on in 2s at speed Count on in 5s at speed Know 10 more or 10 less than 2-digit numbers Know facts relating to number bonds to 20.

The children will be learning about the names of the different continents and oceans of the world. They will be linking this with their learning about the expeditions of Christopher Columbus.

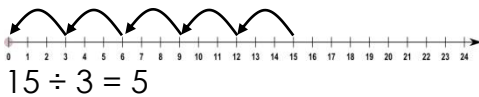

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 9.1.17

In English, the children are continuing their author study of Jeremy Strong by doing work based on the series 'Cartoon Kid'. We will be creating interesting characters and trying to write in the style of Jeremy Strong to make our writing funny.

In maths this week, the children will be continuing their work on division by solving questions and problems that require division calculations. Later in the week they are going to write and solve word problems and apply their knowledge to playing a game involving multiplication and division.



Coming up soon in speedy maths:

w/b 9.1.17	Know division facts relating to 6x table at speed.
w/b 16.1.17	Mentally add pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Know division facts relating to the 6x table at speed. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables at speed.

This week, we are continuing our new themed learning called 'Building a Village'. The children will be researching their new theme and writing quiz questions to test each other's knowledge. The children will learn about Viking raids. As part of this they will design their own Viking long ship and learn about Viking weapons.

Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 9.1.17

In English lessons this week we will continue to focus on play scripts. The children will be using the key features identified last week to create their own play scripts. These play scripts will focus on the value of the month which is honesty.

In maths we are working with decimals again this week. We will be adding and subtracting decimals in the context of money. We will also be working together to solve a pocket money problem.

Coming up soon in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 9.1.17	*Continue simple number patterns Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Give change from £1 at speed.
16.1.17	* Know all tables mixed at speed. Continue simple number patterns Know pairs of numbers to 90. Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed.

In our themed learning this week we are having a science focus. We will be learning about electricity. We will be focussing on circuits, reviewing symbols and how to keep safe near electricity. We will use this knowledge to investigate conductors and insulators.

Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 9.1.17

This week in English the children will be reading extracts from *Black Beauty* by Anna Sewell and considering how the narrator affects the reader. They will be writing their own extract and coming up with open questions for one another using their inference skills. The children will also be revising adverbs, determiners, pronouns and relative clauses.

In maths children will be looking at long multiplication including decimals and applying this knowledge to solve problems.

Coming up in speedy maths:

w.b. 9.1.17	Know pairs of numbers to 100. Use tables to work out related \times and \div at speed. Convert cm to mm and vice versa Know pairs of hundreds to 1000. Add 2-digit to 3-digit numbers
w.b. 16.1.17	Subtract 2-digit from 3-digit numbers Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 180. Convert cm to m and vice versa

In outdoor PE we are starting to work on tag rugby skills.

Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 9.1.17

In English this week, we will be learning about different types of sentences, including statements, commands, exclamations and questions. We will ensure we know how to punctuate these correctly. We will be analysing how different prefixes are used to make the antonyms of words, e.g. possible/impossible. We will continue to develop our reading comprehension skills.

In maths, we will continue our work on fractions, with a focus on finding fractions of shapes and whole numbers, e.g. $\frac{2}{3}$ of 360 is 240.

In speedy maths this week, we will be covering:

w.b: 9.1.17	Know pairs of numbers to 90 Know common equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages. Convert cm to m and vice versa Convert l to ml and vice versa Know number bonds to 1000 (tens)
w.b: 16.1.17	Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Add and subtract p from £&p Use tables to work out related x and ÷ at speed. Convert cm to mm and vice versa Convert m to km and vice versa Add three tens at speed. Add and subtract 2-digit and 3-digit numbers at speed.

In our themed learning, we will be learning about Mount Everest, looking at its physical geography and developing an understanding of the impact humans have on the mountain.
