**Y2 Nativity - Tuesday 6.12.16 – 9.00am – 9.40am and
Y1 Nativity – Friday 9.12.16 – 9.00am – 9.40am**

We are looking forward to welcoming you to school this week for the Y1 and Y2 nativity performances. Please note the following information:

- Each child will have two seats available for family to come and watch the performance. Due to the size of our school hall we do not have unlimited seating therefore, please do not put yourself or school staff in the embarrassing and difficult situation of having to turn people away.
- Entry to the performances will be via the South Gate. Please stand in the queue for your child's class; signs will be on the gate. The gates will be opened at 8.55am and entry will be checked off against a class register.
- If you are entering via the West Gate please use the East Gate and then the car park gate to access the South Gate. There will be no direct access to the hall from the West Gate but people will be able to walk through to the East Gate as soon as the gates open at 8.40am.
- Pre-school children are welcome to attend but will have to sit on an adult's lap. As younger children can become upset or be unpredictably noisy, please use the corridors and Clubroom so that the performance can continue with every child on stage being heard.
- A retiring collection will take place after the performance for the charity Crisis. This charity works all year round but has 10,000 volunteers to help 4,000 homeless people in London alone over the Christmas period. Their aims are to provide real help to homeless people and support people to move onto a better life.
- For safeguarding purposes and the safety of our children, Stamford Green does not give permission for any photos/videos taken at school events by parents/carers to be uploaded to the internet or used on Facebook or any other social networking site. Photos/videos must remain for personal use only. Please also ensure that you are considerate of others when taking photos or filming. Thank you for your co-operation.
