## **Y5 O2 Trip and Performance – Young Voices 19.1.17**

The children's singing in school has been absolutely wonderful as we continue to practice for our forthcoming event! This letter gives you some more details about the Year 5 performance and trip to the O2.

### **Coach for the children**

As the children will be travelling to and from the O2 by coach, we kindly ask for a provisional voluntary donation of £11.76 to cover the registration fee with Young Voices, coach hire and parking costs at the venue. Payment should be made using Tucasi, our online payment system. Please also give your permission for your child to attend the event by fully opening up the trip by double clicking and ticking the box within the trip information section on Tucasi. If you need any assistance with your Tucasi account please contact the school office.

We confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed trip will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the trip. If you would like to pay and are currently experiencing financial difficulties please come and discuss the trip and payment with Mrs Druce as there is always a solution and absolute confidentiality is assured.

The coach will be picking up the children from school at around 12.30pm after they have had their lunch and aims to arrive back at school at 11.30pm. This will be where the children are dismissed after the event. Due to the fact that the O2 will be extremely busy after the event we will not be dismissing children to their parents there. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding as our main priority is keeping your children safe on the night.

### **Choir Clothing**

Young Voices recommend that children wear an official Young Voices t-shirt and this can also be purchased through the school, using the Tucasi online payment system, by selecting the required size. The t-shirt also comes with a free tiny torch, which the children require for the performance. Please be careful to order the correct size, shown in the options, as these cannot be changed. Buying the t-shirt is not essential and the alternative is to wear a plain white t-shirt. Below the t-shirt they request that the children wear school trousers/skirts and school shoes.

### **Audience Tickets**

Tickets for parents/siblings/grandparents are on sale for the O2 performance on 19 January 2017. These can be purchased through the school as it is requested from the venue that they receive one large order per school. The school will then distribute the tickets once they have arrived. Young

Voices organise the audience seats so that each group of parents will be able to see their particular school and children.

Tickets are priced at £22.00 per person, with no restriction as to how many can be bought. Please indicate how many tickets you would like and pay using Tucasi.

Please be aware that tickets are sold on a first come, first serve basis so it is important that tickets are ordered as soon as possible if you require them. Please note that it is not essential for you to purchase tickets to watch as the priority is for the children to experience a once in a life time opportunity of performing at the O2 Arena and being part of a choir, which will consist of over 10,000 students from other schools. It really is an amazing experience that they will remember forever!
