Dear Parents/Carers,

Residential trip to PGL Windmill Hill 18 June – 22 June 2018

I am pleased to announce that we have booked the residential trip for next year's Year 6 pupils at PGL Windmill Hill in East Sussex from Monday 18 June to Friday 22 June 2018.

The centre offers children the chance to take part in a variety of activities such as Abseiling, Archery, Jacob's Ladder, Nature Study, Orienteering, and Raft Building. For more details visit their website. www.pgl.co.uk

Until final numbers are known, we cannot provide an exact cost of the trip as the child cost is worked out by dividing the cost of transport, accommodation and activities by the number of children attending. We are however currently working on a figure of approximately £419.00. Once final numbers have been confirmed the final payment due will be adjusted accordingly.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, you will need to log into Tucasi and go to the trip section, double-click the trip and tick the permission box at the bottom of the page and pay a deposit of £55.00 by Friday 16 June 2017. If you have any problems using the online payment system Tucasi, please contact the office (info@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk).

We have listed the instalment dates below but you can pay as often as you like (e.g. weekly, monthly etc.) and for different amounts using Tucasi.

- First instalment/deposit of £55.00 due by 16 June 2017
- Second instalment of £52.00 due by 21 July 2017
- Third instalment of £52.00 due by 15 September 2017
- Fourth instalment of £52.00 due by 6 October 2017
- Fifth instalment of £52.00 due by 3 November 2017
- Sixth instalment of £52.00 due by 5 January 2018
- Seventh instalment of £52.00 due by 2 February 2018
- **Final balance of £52.00 (this is subject to amendment) due by 31 March 2018**

Although we would like all children to participate in this trip as it is an important part of their growing up and experience tells us that it is an entirely enjoyable experience, it is not compulsory. Children whom do not attend, work in small groups on special projects overseen by a member of staff.

I appreciate that for some families the cost may be a problem. However, the main reason for contacting you now is twofold. It provides time for financial planning and informs us about the viability of the trip.
