## Reception Weekly Information – w/b 15.5.17

It was great to see so many parents/grandparents/carers at Class Open Time last week. The children really enjoyed having the chance to show off their work, so thank you so much for coming.

RM are really looking forward to performing to you, the rest of the school and their families during their Class Assembly on Friday. Please drop your children off to school as usual for registration and enter the School via the Office. Due to space constraints in the hall, the other three Reception classes will be watching RM's final rehearsal on Thursday rather than coming to watch on Friday morning.

Our work on dinosaurs will continue this week – the children have loved sharing all of the information and story books that have been coming in, so feel free to keep sending them! The children will also have their next session of Forest School and continue their learning outdoors.

The children are moving on to Phase 5 of Letters and Sounds this week. Phase 5 is all about different ways of reading and writing the same sound e.g. 'ea' makes the same sound as the familiar sound 'ee' and 'ir' makes the same sound as familiar sound 'er.' We will be focusing on learning to read and write with these two new sounds throughout this week in phonics lessons.

During maths lessons we will start to have our first look at money. The children will be thinking about what makes the coins look different from one another (size, shape and colour) as well as how much the different coins are worth. Our independent activities will focus on revising the previous weeks' learning on distance, time, capacity and weight.

Please make sure that you have sent your child's Golden Book back to school (with a positive comment written on the sticker provided). Each class still has a few outstanding and it is important that they are back in school as soon as possible.

### Things to Remember

- **Ladybirds** turn for Show and Tell on **Thursday 18 May**
- **Forest School reminders:** Your child will not need anything 'extra' for Forest School but it will be essential to have the correct uniform and equipment in school daily: **waterproof coat with hood, water bottle, sun hat.** You may want to apply sun cream at home in the morning.
