Dear Parents/Carers,

Reception Weekly Information – w/b 20.3.17

Wow! What a brilliant end to our 'All About Me' theme the children had last week! We hope you had the chance to hear all about their superhero mission and enjoyed seeing some pictures on Twitter. We are now moving on to 'The World Around Us' ahead of our exciting trip to Godstone Farm later in the week. Please see the separate letters that have been sent out about the trip for all the details. Thanks in advance to all of you who have volunteered to accompany us.

Phonics lessons will continue to focus on those 'trickier' sounds such as 'er,' 'ur,' 'ear,' 'air' and 'ure' alongside using all of our other sounds to read and write. We are continuing to improve our handwriting, letter formation and pace with each phonics lesson!

During maths lessons, we are moving on to learning about the terms 'more' and 'less' in a range of contexts. We will be looking at different amounts of objects and deciding which group has 'more' or 'less' and also thinking about how best to count the objects in order to double check. We will also challenge ourselves to think of a number 'more than' or 'less than' another given number e.g. think of a number less than 10 or number more than 20.

In order to accommodate our trip to the farm, Show and Tell will be for the **Purple** group in **RD and RV** on **Wednesday 22 March** and on **Thursday 23 March** for **RM and RW**. As always with Show and Tell, please ensure that your child's item only comes into school on the day of their turn, is clearly name-labelled and is nothing too precious or expensive.

Finally, a note about Achiever of the Week / Golden Jumpers – you may have noticed that two children from each Reception class were awarded the Golden Jumper last week on a Thursday (in Reception's Year Group assembly). This is because there has been so much exciting stuff going on in school recently that Reception have not always been able to attend our usual Monday assemblies with the rest of the school. The children that are currently wearing the Golden Jumpers will be able to wear them to school up until next Thursday 23 March when they will need to bring their blue jumper to school in order to return the golden ones (RD and RV should do this on Friday as they will be on their farm trip on Thursday).
