Dear Parents/Carers,

Reception Weekly Information – w/b 24.4.17

We will continue to learn about how living things grow and the different signs of spring this week. The children really enjoyed taking part in the tree-planting last week and are looking forward to some (smaller-scale!) growing activities in their classrooms this week.

The children are continuing to work within phase 4 of Letters and Sounds in their phonics lessons. This week we will be revisiting the CVCC words that we first looked at before the holidays. These are words with 'final consonant blends' e.g. mist or silk.

During maths lessons this week we will be focusing on learning how to describe the position of objects e.g. "the bear is on top of the table" or "the book is inside the box." We will be challenging ourselves to extend our sentences, learn new vocabulary and be able to describe an object's whereabouts with accuracy to a partner. Later in the week we will be revising all the different words that describe an object's size and practising how to order things by height, length etc.

As it is Golden Book week, you will have a chance to see all of the fantastic work that your child has been doing! The children will be bringing their Golden Books home at the end of next week. Please remember to write a positive comment about your child's work and return their Golden Book to school once you have had a look through it. The children's next Golden Book week will be during the autumn term in Year 1.
