Reception are continuing to jet off around the world as part of our themed learning work this week. The children have loved learning about different countries and also all about air travel. Each class has enjoyed ‘going on the plane,’ making passports and becoming different members of cabin crew (or even the pilot!). As our theme continues, we would love for the children to have a ‘suitcase’ to put their work into. If at all possible, please send in shoe box (or two if you have spare!) for your child to make into a little suitcase. It is also a really fun project to do at home if you would like to work on it with your child and send in the finished thing.



Over our last few weeks we will be recapping a range of maths concepts we have covered over the year, particularly focusing on 2D and 3D shapes, 1 more and 1 less of numbers to 20, doubling and halving.

The children will start to go out at morning break from Wednesday this week as part of their transition to Year 1. They are already familiar with the playground and listening for the music for when to come in as it is the same routine after lunch. The teaching assistants from YR will be out on the playground so there will be lots of familiar faces for the children.

The children are helping Year 6 with some of their class work on Friday afternoon as they have been asked to judge their ‘healthy snack’ designs. They will be tasting a range of snacks and giving their valuable feedback to the Year 6 children.
