Dear Parents/Carers,

3S Residential Trip – The Golden Hinde – Thursday 7 June 2018 to Friday 8 June 2018

We have provisionally booked a one night residential trip aboard The Golden Hinde in London on Thursday 7 June 2018. The children will leave school at approximately 9.15am and return on Friday 8 June 2018 at approximately 11.00am. There will then be the option to collect your child at 12.15pm or they can continue their adventure at school until 3.15pm.

We will start the day by dropping our bags at The Golden Hinde before walking to the Tower of London for a workshop about Henry VIII and his wives. We will spend the rest of the day exploring the Tower of London. We will then walk the short distance to the Golden Hinde where the children will have dinner and spend the night on board the docked galleon.

A residential trip is a wonderful opportunity to develop the children's independence and team building. The children will be introduced to a sailors' life in Tudor times and take part in different activities. They will spend the night sleeping on the gun deck among the cannons which will be followed by a traditional Tudor breakfast in the morning. Until final numbers are known, we cannot provide an exact cost of the trip as the per child cost is worked out by dividing the cost of transport, accommodation and activities by the number of children attending. We are, however, currently working on a figure of between £82 - £90. As soon as numbers have been confirmed we will advise you of the final price (these figures are based on all children attending).

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, you will need to log into Tucasi and go to the trip section and tick the consent box and pay a deposit of £25.00 by Wednesday 6 December 2017. If you have any problems using the online payment system Tucasi, please contact the school office or email info@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk. If we have not received your permission and deposit by Wednesday 6 December we will assume that you do not wish your child to take part. Unfortunately, once we have booked the trip we may not be able to add any more children so it is important that you respond by the deadline if you wish your child to attend.

Two further instalment dates will be due by Friday 16 March 2018 and Friday 13 April 2018. The March instalment will be £30.00 and we will advise you of the final amount in April. The payments must be made by these dates but you can make additional instalment payments as often as you like.
