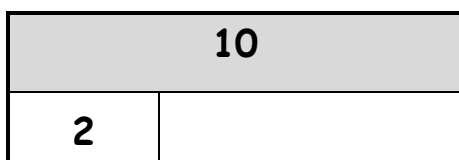
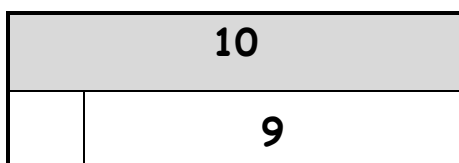
Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 15.1.18

In English this week we will be focusing on non-fiction writing. The theme of this will be about seasons. The children will be learning how to use main headings and sub headings in order to lay out their writing clearly. If the children have any books about seasons, they are welcome to bring them in. Please ensure they are named.

In maths this week the children will be starting to learn about bar models for addition. The children will be starting to learn how to work out what missing numbers would be based on the size of the section that is missing e.g. Add the two bottom numbers together to find the total.



We will also use this for number bonds to 10 e.g.



In our themed learning, we will be learning about dates, in particular years and where and when our families were born. This will link to the sheets the children did at home over the Christmas holidays so if your child still needs to bring this in to school, please could they do this in the next few days.

Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 15.1.18

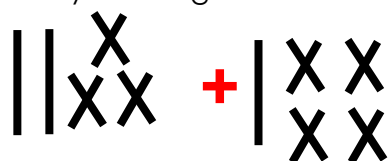
In English this week, we will be continuing our poetry unit and will be focusing on shape poems. The children will be using their understanding of alliteration to add detail to their writing. As part of our grammar input we will learn about homophones (words that sound the same but are spelt differently) and revise suffixes and conjunctions.

In maths lessons this week, the children will be beginning some work on addition. They will be linking previous learning on place value to enable them to add tens and ones at speed as well as consolidating their understanding of addition as the sum of two numbers. Key to the children's secure understanding will be that knowing that the inverse of addition is subtraction and that subtraction can be used as a checking system for addition. E.g. $7+4=11$ ($11-4=7$). The children will be adding 1 digit numbers to 2 digit numbers, two 2 digit numbers (including a multiple of 10) and two digit numbers of any value (where there is no exchange). Lots of the addition we will be doing this week will be practical, using plenty of equipment to help make these concepts concrete in the children's understanding.

E.g. $23 + 14 = 37$ can be represented using the dienes like this:



Or by drawing sticks and crosses (mental calculation strategy) like this:

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 15.1.18

In English, the children are continuing their author study of Jeremy Strong by doing work based on the series 'Cartoon Kid'. We will be thinking about characters, working on understanding stories and describing places.

In maths this week, the children will be continuing their work on division by solving questions and problems that require division calculations. Later in the week they are going to write and solve word problems and apply their knowledge to playing a game involving multiplication and division.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

In our themed learning this week, the children will be learning more about Viking settlements. We will be learning about what a Viking house looked like and what it might have been like to live inside one. They will be comparing life inside a Viking house with that of their own modern homes.

Hopefully, last week your child brought home an invitation to attend a Year 3 maths workshop next Tuesday (23.1.18) at 9-9.45am. This will be a chance to work with your child on a few different maths activities. Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 15.1.18

On Tuesday 23 January we are holding our SRE (Sexual Relationships Education) talk for parents at 2.30pm - 3.00 pm. We will be showing the DVD which we will be watching with the children in class on Friday. We will assume that you are happy for your child to take part in the lesson unless we hear from you to the contrary by Thursday 25 January.

In English lessons this week, we will be looking at famous speeches. We will be identifying the key features of a successful speech so that we can write our own speech to persuade our classmates that the British person we have chosen is the greatest! Later in the week, the children will be presenting their speeches to each other.

In maths we are working with decimals again this week. We will be adding and subtracting decimals in the context of money. We will also be working together to solve a pocket money problem.

In our themed learning this week we are continuing our work on great British artists/bands. In geography we will be labelling human and physical features of the United Kingdom using an atlas to help us.

Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 15.1.18

In English this week, we will be summarising information and conveying key facts through the medium of comic strips. We will be using our history learning in theme as a basis for these – the space race.

In maths, we will be looking at data handling and how information is presented in different ways. We will be interrogating graphs to answer questions.

In speedy maths this week, we will be covering the following areas:

w.b: 15.1.18	Subtract 2-digit from 3-digit numbers	Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 180. Convert cm to m and vice versa
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w.b: 22.1.18	Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Subtract 2-digit from 3-digit numbers Convert L to ml and vice versa Use tables to work out related x and ÷ at speed.
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We will be starting our spelling and times tables tests again this week. For the spellings, we will focus on 'competition' to 'desperate' at the back of the Learning Journal. The times tables test will focus on both the 2x and 3x tables, including related division facts, eg $5 \times 3 = 15$, $15 \div 3 = 5$.

This week in our themed learning, we will be learning about the space race – its origins, contributing factors, successes and future. In computing, we will be creating covers for our space books. In geography, we will be learning about the composition of the Earth and how it is made up of different layers.

The children will continue to practise for 'Young Voices' that is taking place on 1 February. They are sounding absolutely fantastic and can't wait to perform at the O2.

Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 15.1.18

In English this week, we are writing the first draft of a report on the impact of tourism on Mount Everest. We will then be learning some skills to edit and then apply these to improve our own writing.

The spelling rule for this week is using the correct suffix for the 'shun' sound. Either: tion, sion, ssion or cian.

In maths we are learning the properties of 3D shapes and the vocabulary used to describe these properties. We will be exploring nets later in the week and applying our knowledge in order to solve problems.

In our Whanau groups this week, we will be sharing a favourite picture book. Please could your child bring in a book they would like to read with their group (please write their name in it) into school on Wednesday morning. Any children who do not bring one in will have the opportunity to visit the school library. They may like to practise reading it at home to an audience before they bring it in and think about the questions they could ask the children in their group.
