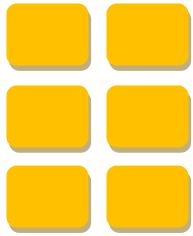


### Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 26.3.18

In English, we will be trying to get in as much reading as possible to help with the 100 million reading minute challenge! We will also be continuing to focus on our spelling during our half termly spelling test. Later in the week we will be using drama to help with our imaginative description and our use of adverbs.

In maths, we will be continuing our work on multiplication. We will be drawing arrays and writing number sentences that go with them – these will include multiplication sentences as well as repeated addition sentences.

E.g.



Multiplication sentence:

$$2 \times 3 = 6$$

OR  $3 \times 2 = 6$

Repeated addition sentence:

$$3 + 3 = 6$$

OR  $2 + 2 + 2 = 6$

### Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 26.3.18

In English this week, the children will be linking their reading and writing skills with RE, through learning about the Easter story. They will be learning about the idea of sacrifice and the events and significance of the different days in the Easter story.

### Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 26.3.18

In RE we are looking at the significance of Lent for Christians and the Easter story, with a particular focus on how Christians prepare for Easter in different ways.

### Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 26.3.18

In English this week, we will be looking at persuasion. Children spent time last week learning about Brunel and some of his achievements. This week they will attempt to persuade others about whether or not Brunel should be considered the greatest ever Briton.

In maths, we will continue to look at fractions. Children will explore equivalent fractions and using the four operations with fractions.

In speedy maths this week, we will be covering the following areas:

<b>26.3.18</b>	Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Add and subtract p from £&p Convert m to km and vice versa
<b>16.4.18</b>	Know pairs of numbers to 100. Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Add and subtract p from £&p Convert L to ml and vice versa Use tables to work out related x and ÷ at speed.

This week in our themed learning, we will be looking at the Easter story. Children will be examining the different gospel accounts and trying to suggest reasons for inconsistencies.

Finally we'd like to thank you all for coming to the shows last week and for providing such amazing costumes. Both classes performed really well and we're really proud of them!

### **Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 26.3.18**
