Year 1 Weekly Information w/b 5.2.18

Due to huge popularity of the Mr Men books, we have decided to spend another week with Roger Hargreaves as our author. We will be enjoying more of the stories; using the Mr Men in our maths; and completing our Puppet project in DT. During maths this week we will be sorting shapes using Carroll Diagrams and thinking about how to talk about the properties of shape. We will also start thinking about how we can use number facts that we already know to work out related facts.

e.g. if we know $4 + 6 = 10$ we know $4 + 7 = 11$

Our half termly spelling test will be happening this week.

Tuesday is Safer Internet Day, so we will re-visit and discuss keeping safe online following on from our lessons earlier this term.

We will also be showing the children the SRE DVD and completing some accompanying work to support this.

The children will be having Show and Tell on Thursday 8 February. Please make sure items are named and no toys please!

After half term the children will be attending the Synagogue to support their learning about Judaism. The Synagogue have asked if boys can bring a hat on the day they are visiting (a cap or sun hat is acceptable). This is only a request and the Synagogue will not enforce the wearing of a hat however as a mark of respect for different faiths we feel it is important to encourage the child to do so.

We still need volunteers for the trip in order for it to go ahead. At the moment we need four extra volunteers for Tuesday and Wednesday and five for Thursday. Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 5.2.18

We hope that you have enjoyed looking through your child's Golden Book with them. Please can you complete the parent comment sticker at the end of the week's work and return them to school by Thursday for safe keeping.

This week is Eco Week and as part of this, we will be working on an upcycling project involving plastic – we will be using the plastic drinks bottles you have been sending in to create colourful planters which will brighten up the fence area outside the Y2 classrooms – we are looking forward to growing some lovely flowers in them after half term. If you haven't sent a bottle in yet, don't worry – you still have time to bring one in tomorrow.

In English, we will be continuing with our creative writing on Moana. The children will be writing a letter to Moana's father. There will also be a focus on reading as we will be testing the children's

comprehension skills. The children will also have their half termly random 20 word Y2 High Frequency Word spelling test – look out for how they've done with this in their Learning Journals.

This week's maths will involve looking at the children's overall understanding of all the addition concepts and strategies taught this half term. This will help us to guide the learning after half term.

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 5.2.18

This week in Year 3, the children will be continuing to work on their persuasive writing. As part of our Eco Week activities, we are going to look at the benefits of recycling and write persuasively about why recycling is a good idea.

In maths, we will be working on telling the time. Monday's lesson was focussed on finding out the children's current confidence with telling the time. For the remainder of the week, the children will be developing their skills – this could be telling the time using o'clock and half past; quarter to and quarter past; telling the time to the nearest five minutes; telling the time to the nearest minute; using the 24 hour clock; or finding intervals of time.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

w/b 5.2.18	Know division facts relating to 4x table at speed. Mentally add pairs of 2-digit numbers. Know pairs of numbers to 20. Know 10 more and 10 less than 3-digit numbers. Know division facts for 2x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables
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w/b 19.2.18	Mentally subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers. Know division facts for 4x table. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables. Add pairs of tens at speed.
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On Tuesday we are looking forward to seeing the Year 2 and 3 children perform in the Phase 2 Talent Show. We're certain there will be a huge range of talent on display.

To tie in with Eco Week, on Wednesday and Thursday, we are going to be making some art using plastic bags. Thank you to everyone who has sent us some plastic bags for us to use. If you have any plastic bags that would otherwise be thrown away or linger in a cupboard for years, please send in a few with your child. The artwork would look better with a range of colours so unusual colours would be gratefully received.

Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 5.2.18

In English this week, we will be focusing on reading skills. Children will be completing a reading assessment. Time will then be given to look through answers and discuss how they could be improved.

In maths, we will be revising for our summary of learning. Children will complete their assessment which features questions from many of the aspects of maths covered so far. Children will then be given time to look through their assessments and explore the questions they found hard.

In speedy maths this week, we will be covering the following areas:

Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 5.2.18

In English this week we are applying our inference skills as well as our skimming and scanning techniques to a piece of text. We are also practising how to answer more in-depth questions using P.E.E. We make our **P**oint 'I think.....' then use **E**vidence from the text ...'because...' then **E**xplain'...this shows...'

In maths we are finishing our work on reflecting and translating as well as revising our knowledge of negative numbers and exploring number patterns and sequences of numbers.
