We are pleased to inform you that we have arranged visits to the British Wildlife Centre as detailed above for Year 1. These visits will be a valuable contribution to our 'Sensational World' theme, which includes learning about British wildlife and plants, and promises to be an exciting day!

We will leave at approximately 9.15am and we should be back at school by 3.05pm, although this is dependent on traffic.

Children should wear smart school uniform. Depending on the weather at the time, a waterproof jacket or a sunhat will also be needed. In the case of hot weather please ensure your child is wearing sun protection cream when they come to school.

The children will need a packed lunch. If your child usually has a school meal on the day they visit the British Wildlife Centre it will be provided by the school kitchen. However, if you wish to send additional snacks to supplement the lunch then you are most welcome but please respect that we are a nut-free school and no fizzy drinks are permitted.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £15.03 and we confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed visit will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the visit. If you are currently experiencing financial difficulties please come and discuss the visit and payment with Mrs Druce as there is always a solution and absolute confidentiality is assured.

If you agree to your son/daughter participating in the visit, please log into Tucasi, go to the trip section and tick the consent box for the trip and pay the voluntary contribution of £15.03.
