Dear Parents/Carers,

## Year 2 Road Safety Pedals Training Course – 9, 10, 11 and 12 October 2018

We have arranged with Surrey County Council to offer Year 2 children a Pedals Training Course. The course will last for 1 hour and there will be 15 children in each session. The course provides an excellent opportunity for pupils to continue their road safety education. The aims of the course are detailed in the attached guide for parents. From this you will also note that children can attend the course on any of the following modes of transport:

- A bicycle (which they can ride, with or without stabilisers)
- A tricycle
- A scooter
- On foot (for those who do not possess any of the above)

The groups of fifteen children will be chosen nearer the time so you will know which day the bicycle/tricycle/scooter needs to be brought into school. The cost is £5.00 per child. We have spaces for all the children in Y2 so everybody will be able to partake in this training, although it is not compulsory.

At the end of the course, your child will receive a certificate of participation showing which skills they have demonstrated.

If you would like your child to participate in the Pedals Training Course, you will need to log into Tucasi, go to the trip section, open up Pedals Training fully, tick the permission box and pay £5.00 by **Monday 1 October 2018**. The forms that are required to be read in order for your child to participate are also attached to this letter so please ensure that you read them thoroughly.

Children will need to bring their bicycles/scooters and helmets to school at 8.30am on the course day and use either the East or West Gates to take them to the ball cage each morning. If you have a lock please bring it with you so that bicycles can be secured to the ball cage fence just in case as the school cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage. Please remind your child that they should not be cycling/scootering once they are on school premises. The Year 2 teachers will be in the ball cage on these mornings to help with locks, if needed.
