Year 2 The Baitul Futuh Mosque Trip – Wednesday 22 November 2017

To fit in with our learning about Islam, we have arranged a visit to The Baitul Futuh Mosque in Morden on Wednesday 22 November. The purpose of the visit is to allow the children to experience and learn about different aspects of this religion first-hand. The children and parents from last year thoroughly enjoyed the trip and the teachers were impressed by how much it enhanced the children's learning.

We will be leaving school at 9.00am and we should be back at school by 2.00pm. The children should wear school uniform and will all need a packed lunch. If your child usually has a school meal on Thursdays it will be provided by the school kitchen. However, if you wish to send additional snacks in you are most welcome to. We have been advised by the Mosque that the children may eat whatever they wish but please respect that we are a nut-free school. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has plenty to drink but no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please. You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £7.06 to cover the cost of the visit.
