Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 4 Residential Trip – High Ashurst – 13 to 15 June 2018

I am pleased to announce that we have booked a two night residential trip at High Ashurst near Dorking from Wednesday 13 June to Friday 15 June 2018.

A residential trip is a wonderful opportunity to develop the children's independence and team building skills as well as having lots of fun! High Ashurst Outdoor Learning Centre is set in 56 acres of woodland on Boxhill, near Dorking. The centre offers a wide range of activities such as orienteering, low rope activities and our timetable will be confirmed before we go. Our theme of learning for the term is survival and to compliment this the children will be camping out in tepees. However, the food at the centre is delicious, not like survival rations!

Until final numbers are known, we cannot provide an exact cost of the trip as the 'per child' cost is worked out by dividing the cost of transport, accommodation and activities by the number of children attending. We are, however, currently working on a figure of between £140.00 and £160.00. As soon as numbers have been confirmed, we will advise you of the final price.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip, you will need to log onto Tucasi, go to the trip section, double click the required trip to open it up fully, tick the permission box (available from tomorrow) and pay a deposit of £20 by Friday 13 October 2017. If you have not given your permission and paid the deposit by this date we will assume that you do not wish your child to take part. Unfortunately, once we have finalised the details and booked the trip we may not be able to add any more children, so it is important that you respond by the deadline if you wish your child to attend.

Further payments of £60 will be due by Friday 24 November 2017, Friday 26 January 2018 and the final balance, once known, will be due by Thursday 30 March 2018, although payments can be made through Tucasi at any time in any denomination.
