Dear Parents/Carers,

Y6 Visit to Epsom, Ewell and Mole Valley Junior Citizen Event – Thursday 15 March 2018

We have arranged for our Year 6 pupils to attend an exciting and useful event at Epsom Downs Race Course organised by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Surrey on Thursday 15 March 2018. In previous years children who have attended have thoroughly enjoyed this event and the skills learnt have proved useful when they have been confronted with emergency situations.

The Junior Citizen is a multi-agency safety event designed to provide children with life skills that will enable them to keep themselves and others safe. It is generally accepted that children start to become more independent at this age and are often expected to cope increasingly on their own and deal with changes in their lives, such as a move to secondary school. The aim of The Junior Citizen event is to raise each participant's awareness of threats and dangers, and what to do, in a fun and interactive way.

We will be travelling by coach and leaving school around 12.15pm and will be returning at approximately 3.15pm. The children will be going into lunch early this day to allow them time to eat before we depart. The children should be wearing full school uniform and school shoes.

You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £7.50 to cover the cost of attendance at this event. The voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed trip will not be viable if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the trip. If you would like to pay and are currently experiencing financial difficulties please come and discuss the trip and payment with Mrs Druce as there is always a solution and absolute confidentiality is assured.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip you will need to log into Tucasi and go to the trip section, tick the consent box and pay the voluntary contribution of £7.50 by Monday 5 March 2018 or as soon as possible. If you have any problems using the online payment system Tucasi, please contact the school office.

We will need parent helpers to assist on this trip and would be grateful if you could indicate on Tucasi if you are able to help and enjoy the trip too.
