We are looking forward to welcoming you to school for the Nursery Nativity Tableaux. Please note the following information:

- Please can your child come dressed in their costume on the morning of their performance, the dates are as follows: **Thursday 14 December and Tuesday 19 December**. Full time children will be required to perform on both days.
- The children will come into Nursery at the normal time. Parents will need to wait at the office entrance and will be let in ready for the performance to begin at 9.00am. Any siblings going to the crèche can be dropped off once you have come in through the office doors.
- Each child will have two seats available for family to come and watch the performance. Due to the size of our school hall we do not have unlimited seating therefore, please do not put yourself or school staff in the embarrassing and difficult situation of having to turn people away. Please note that no actual tickets will be issued and a register will be used upon entry.
- A retiring collection will take place after the performance for the charity the World Wildlife Fund. The mission of WWF is to conserve nature and reduce the most pressing threats to the diversity of life on Earth. The decision to support this charity was made by the children in Y1 to Y6 their Whanau groups (this week's newsletter will explain more).
