Nursery Weekly Information – w/b 25.9.17

We are so proud of how well your little ones have settled into Nursery!

This week will be our first week of the children doing their full sessions. Please be patient with us during drop off and pick up times! We will take our time so we make sure it happens in a calm and safe way. We will be registering your child as they enter the gate in the morning, this may take time locating names on list etc. At the end of the day the children must not leave the gate before a member of the team has said their name (the children were brilliant at this last week). Please try not to call out their name as they will automatically run to you.

If you would like to speak to one of us in the morning then we ask if you could do this once you have settled your child. You can either catch us at the gate on your way out or leave a message in the message book (this book will be available at each gate). Alternatively if you need a longer time to discuss an issue then please ask for a meeting at the end of the day.

Last week the children were all given a Learning Journal and reading book of their choice to bring home. Please feel free to change this reading book when you drop off your child in the morning, a box of books will be available in both the rooms. It is very important that you record what reading has taken place at home, this way we can see how much reading they are doing and how they are getting on. The comments don't have to be long and detailed, just a couple of sentences about how it went for example...

- What was their favourite character or part in the story
- Could they predict what the story was about from the front cover
- Could they predict the ending
- Were they able to answer questions or talk about the pictures

The children will need to bring their book bags in every day.

Thank you for providing a change of clothes bag, please make sure they contain pants, socks and an old pair of shoes. Could we ask that the children bring in wellies so that they can be kept in school.



Due to the fact that we are a 'community nursery' we are not able to access funding which provides fruit free of charge. To solve this problem we are going to trial the idea that every child brings in their own piece of fruit. They are allowed to bring in fresh or dried fruit but they won't be allowed any processed fruit snacks such as Yo-Yos or Fruit Winders. Please can we remind you to cut up grapes, tomatoes, blueberries and other small items!

Thank you all for your support and enthusiasm. We feel it has been a fantastic start and look forward to the week ahead.
