Show and Tell on Thursday: Ladybirds group.

This week we continue our quest to travel the world! We fly a very long distance to Australia and explore the natural beauty of the Great Barrier Reef and visit some of the top tourist attractions such as the Sydney Opera House and Uluru. We will look into Indigenous Aboriginal art work as we have a go at painting our own take on it.

In maths we will use a range of objects to explore mathematical concepts in our play, such as addition, subtraction, doubling and halving. We will also recap our knowledge of money – independently sorting different coins.

Between now and the end of term we will be recapping all of the sounds that we have learnt so far. This will involve recognising the sounds at speed, writing the sounds in words and reading words and sentences. We are really proud of how much progress all of the children have made with their phonics this year. Watch out next week for lots of ideas from our Phonics in Action Workshop which you might use over the summer to keep up with regular phonics practice!

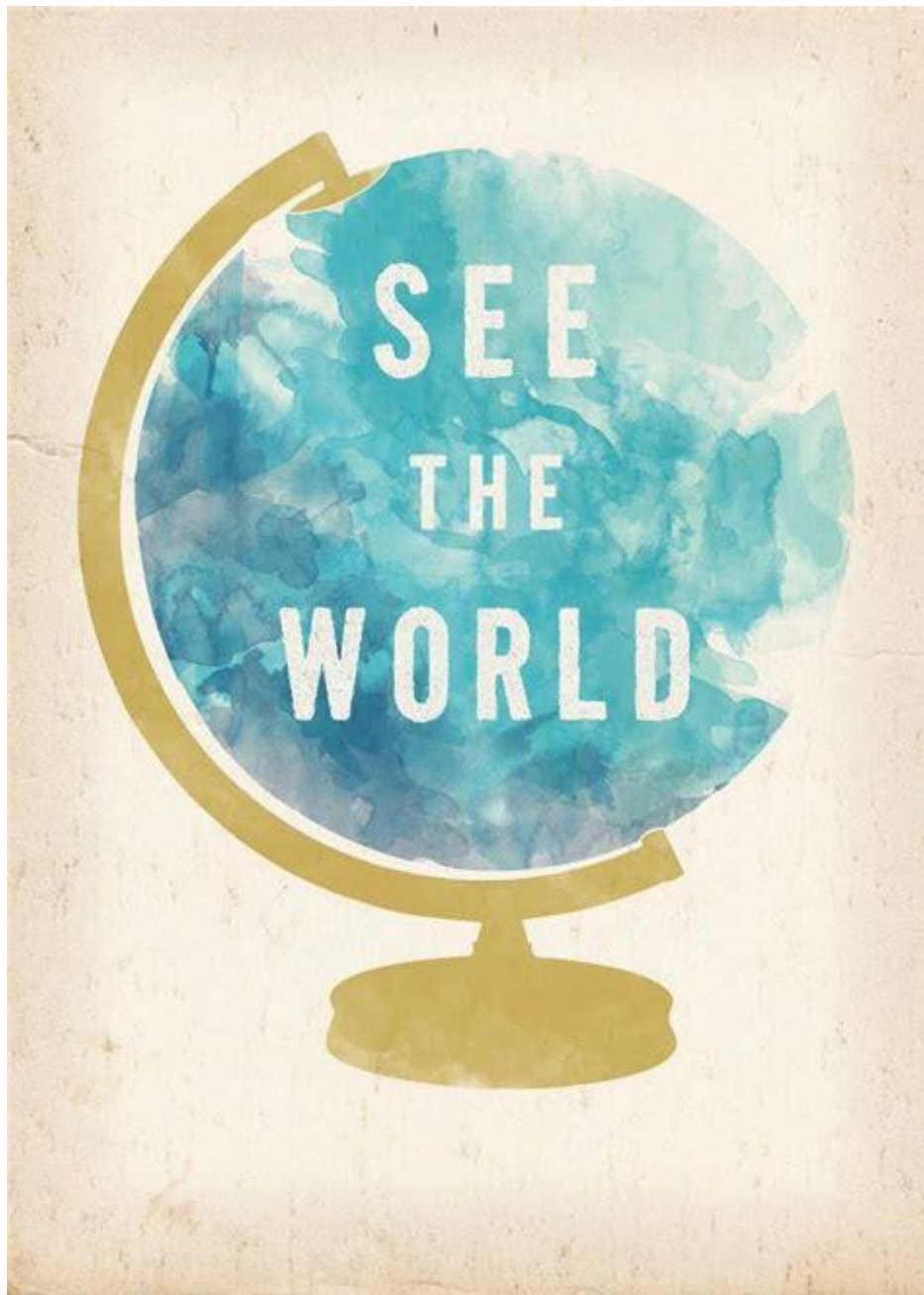
