Dear Parents/Carers,

Tree Planting – Langley Vale Centenary Wood

Your child has been selected to represent the school at a tree planting event on Wednesday 14 November. We will be taking our tree saplings (that have grown from the seeds we planted in 2016) and planting them to form part of the Woodland Trust's Centenary Wood at Langley Vale.

The event is due to start at 9.30am, so your child will need to be collected from school immediately after the morning register and taken to the venue. As access is limited, please can you arrange for car-sharing as much as possible. A map is attached to this letter for your reference. A member of the Woodland Trust's team will be located at the gates on Hurst Road to allow vehicles through.

Children will need to be dressed appropriately, wearing water proof shoes, boots or wellingtons and have warm waterproof clothing including gloves. They should wear trousers and change them on return to school in the afternoon. The event is due to finish at 11.30am and we will be back at school in time for the children to have their lunch.

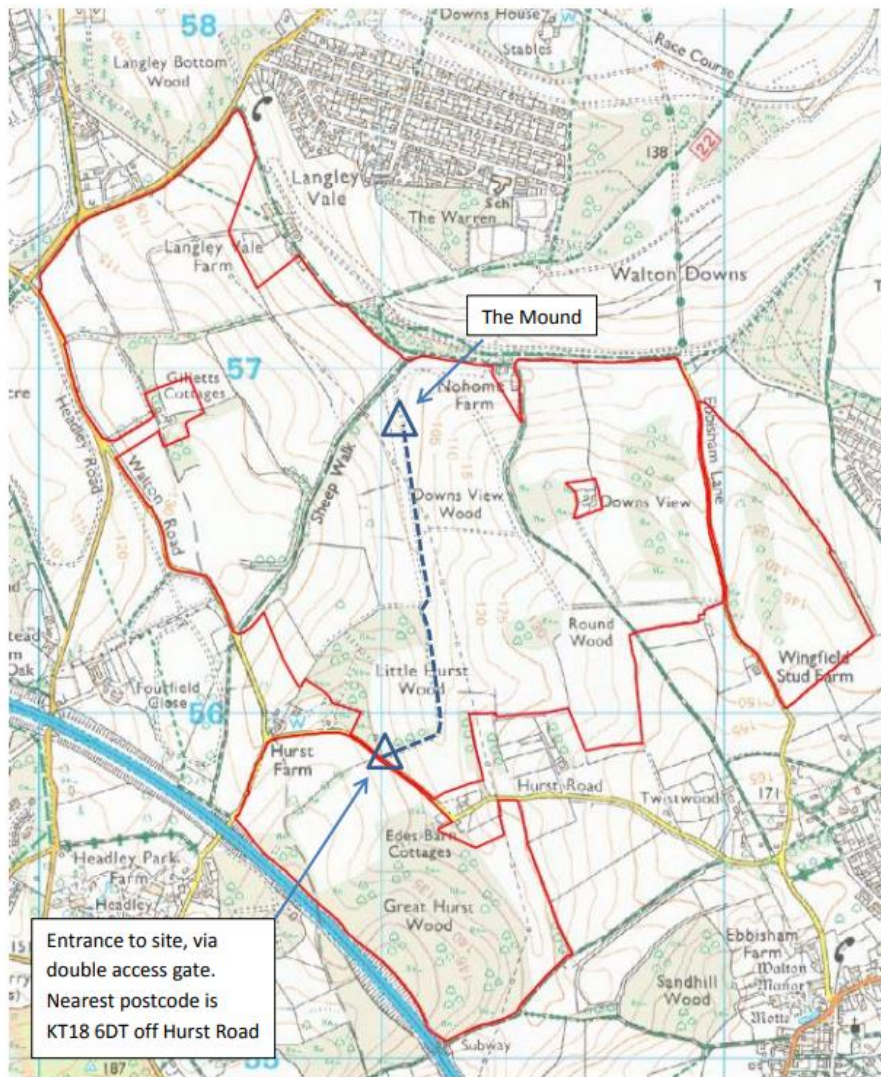

If you are travelling from Epsom, head out of Epsom on Ashley Road/A24 for 1.5 miles. Upon reaching the traffic lights at Epsom Racecourse, turn right onto Langley Vale Road. Follow for just over a mile and turn left onto Headley Road at the T junction. At the fork in the road, keep left onto Walton Road and follow for half a mile. At the Junction turn left on Hurst Road, following the signs for Tadworth.

The gates will be marked with a temporary Woodland Trust sign so that you do not miss the entrance. The off road track is suitable for vehicles but please drive slowly particularly on the descent from Hurst Road. Drive along the track following the dotted blue route shown on the map and you will come eventually to an area we call the Mound where our team will be to greet you.

There is room at the Mound to turn vehicles around and park, and we will have a mobile toilet there for your use.
