This week in English, we are exploring similes and alliteration in more detail by looking at, and writing our own, poetry. We will put these ideas into a piece of descriptive writing. Our maths lessons this week are going to begin by focusing on refining our graph drawing and the children will also be completing a summary of learning task using all the different skills that we have been practising this half term.

w/b 29.10.18	Add two tens at speed. Know 3x and 4x tables at speed. Know 10 more and 10 less than 3 digit numbers.

Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 15.10.18

In English lessons this week, we will be learning to improve and edit our work. We will also be reviewing our reading test to see where we could improve. This week we will also test the children on 20 words from the Y4 spelling list. Your support with helping the children to learn these spellings would be greatly appreciated.

In maths, the children will be taking part in an open ended problem solving task where they will have to work collaboratively, whilst exploring different aspects of mathematics in order to reach a solution.

Coming up soon in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 15.10.18	Know 7x table at speed. Know 9x table at speed. Add and subtract pairs of 2-digit numbers at speed. Know halves and doubles of numbers to 20. Know number bonds to 20.
w/b 29.10.18	*Know 8x table at speed Add and subtract hundreds and 3-digit numbers. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Divide any number by 10. Know pairs of numbers to 100.

As part of our themed learning, Greece is the Word, the children will be learning about the Ancient Olympic Games and comparing them with the modern day Olympics. We will then be holding our own mini Olympic Games. When we started our Ancient Greek theme, we asked the children what they would like to learn about. This week, they will have the opportunity to choose one or two of these areas to research. They will then present their findings in a format of their choosing, for example a leaflet or a poster.

w.b: 29.10.18	Know pairs of numbers to 90 Know all tables to 12×12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 180. Convert cm to m and vice versa.
