Welcome back and we hope you had a great half term!

Due to the popularity of Julia Donaldson's stories we are pleased to say that we will continue to look at her books this week. During our English lessons we will be thinking about how to describe the characters in the Julia Donaldson books and we will be writing our own description of a Julia Donaldson character. We will also be sharing the many Julia Donaldson books that the children have brought in from home. Please ensure that they are named.

In maths we will also be beginning to look at measuring and using non-standard measuring such as cubes. The children seem to be really enjoying their daily speedy maths challenge. This week we

are focussing on knowing the order of numbers at speed, with the children filling in missing numbers in number sequences.

This week children will be bringing home the list of spelling words for this half term and these are the words we will be focusing on in "Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check". It is our aim that these are spelt correctly each time we use them in our own writing. The words for this half term are: dad, big, will, back, him, get, got, that, with, this, went, then, them, from, the, be, he, they, are, what.

Year 2 Weekly Information w/b 29.10.18

Welcome back to the second half of the autumn term. This week sees the beginning of our rehearsals for our Christmas production as we start learning the words to the songs.

In English we will be continuing on our theme of space and aliens. We will read the story 'Man on the Moon – a day in the life of Bob' by Simon Bartram. The children will be practising how to use conjunctions in their writing as well as investigating past and present tense verbs and how their endings change. At the end of the week, the children will write their own adventure about what Bob gets up to on the moon!

In maths we will be looking at patterns and using our knowledge of 2s, 5s and 10s to solve problems. Remember to keep practising your 2 times table at home as we will be practising knowing this at speed this week.

Year 3 Weekly Information w/b 29.10.18

This week in English, we will mostly be working on reading skills. We are beginning a new class book 'The Mystery of the Strange Bundle' by Enid Blyton and will be using this to develop our inference and question asking skills this week.

We are going to begin our maths lessons this week by revisiting our learning from last half term. We are then going to use some of the skills we practised last half term to solve problems using a systematic approach.

Coming up soon in speedy maths:

w/b 29.10.18	Add two tens at speed. Know 4x table at speed. Know 3x table at speed. Add and subtract 2-digit to 1-digit at speed.
w/b 5.11.18	Add two tens at speed. Know 3x and 4x tables at speed. Know 10 more and 10 less than 3 digit numbers.

During our themed learning, the children will be thinking about the very beginnings of people by looking at and creating their own cave art. As previously advised, on Thursday afternoon (1.11.18) we will be creating a big cave art project. We would like to invite you to join your child for this activity from 2.20pm. If you do wish to join us, please arrive at the school office shortly before 2.20pm and we will meet you at the office.

Year 4 Weekly Information w/b 29.10.18

We hope you had a lovely half term. It was great to welcome the children back and hear their news. Hopefully you enjoyed sharing your child's Golden Books with them. Please can you write a positive comment on the sticker and return them to school as soon as possible.

In English lessons this week, the children will be looking at autumn poems. They will be spotting poetic devices in the poems and using these to write their own autumn poems focusing on creating atmosphere.

In maths, the children will be focusing on multiplication. They will be using the grid method to multiply two digit and three digit numbers by one/two digit numbers. Please continue to practise times tables with your children as quick recall is essential for this method.

e.g. 235 x 4

Coming up soon in speedy maths (* indicates new learning):

w/b 29.10.18	* Know 8x table at speed Add and subtract hundreds and 3-digit numbers. Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Divide any number by 10. Know pairs of numbers to 100.
w/b 5.11.18	* Give change from £1 at speed Know 8x table at speed Know 2x, 3x, 4x, 5x, 6x, 10x tables and related division facts at speed. Add and subtract tens with 3-digit numbers at speed. Know pairs of tens to 90

In Science this week, we will be exploring 'States of Matter' and learning about the differences between solids, liquids and gases. As this year it will have been 100 years since the end of WW1, for Remembrance Day we will be making clay poppies to display in school.

Next week, will be having an **Ancient Greek Day on Friday 9 November**. We would like the children to come to school dressed in Ancient Greek costume please.

Ana in 4J would like to raise some money for the Royal Brompton and Harefield Hospital Charity. Harefield Hospital is the largest specialist heart and lung centre in the UK, and this charity is very close to Ana and her family. To support her, some of Year 4 would like to sell cakes at playtime on Thursday 1 November to Y3 – Y6. We would really appreciate some homemade cakes, cookies etc. so if you would like to make some, please bring them in on Thursday 1 November.

At the end of this half term we will be testing the children on 20 words from the Year 4 spelling list. Before learning any new words, it would be helpful to revise any words that your child did not spell correctly in the test at the end of last half term. It is expected that the children will know all the Year 4 spellings by the end of the year. Your support with this matter is much appreciated.

Year 5 Weekly Information w/b 29.10.18

Welcome back and we hope everyone had a fantastic half term break.

In English, we will be starting a carousel of different activities focused on grammar, punctuation, vocabulary, reading and handwriting. We will work in small groups, tackling a different challenge each day.

In maths, we will be looking at the key vocabulary of factors, multiples, product, prime numbers, square and cube numbers and applying our knowledge to investigate and solve problems.

In speedy maths this week, we will be covering the following areas:

w.b: 29.10.18	Know pairs of numbers to 90 Know all tables to 12x12 including division facts at speed. Know pairs of numbers to 180. Convert cm to m and vice versa.
w.b: 5.11.18	Convert m to km and vice versa Know pairs of numbers to 100. Use tables to work out related \times and \div at speed.

In our themed learning this week and next, we will be looking at remembrance, which is especially poignant as it is the centenary of the end of the First World War. This topic will inspire our cross-curricular learning, encompassing English, computing, art and history.

This Friday, we will concentrate on the next five Year 5 words from the back of the Learning Journal (lightning – opportunity) and the 8x table. In the times table test, we will demonstrate our knowledge of the table in random order and when we use related division facts, e.g. $6 \times 8 = 48$; $32 \div 8 = 4$. The last five questions in the test came from any table we've practised so far.

Year 6 Weekly Information w/b 29.10.18

This week in English, we will be revising how to use dashes accurately in our writing. Later in the week, we will be focusing on handwriting and the correct formation and joining of all letters. The children are required to form letters correctly in order to meet the expected standard.

This week's spelling rule is -cious and -tious

- If the root word ends in ce e.g. space, remove the e and replace with ious.
E.g. space – spacious
- If the root word ends in tion e.g. nutrition, remove the n and replace with us.
E.g. nutrition – nutritious
- There are some exceptions to the above rules e.g. delicious, fictitious and anxious.

In maths, we will be revising prime numbers as well as looking at prime factors, square and cubed numbers. Later in the week, we will be introducing the children to BODMAS/BIDMAS.

In science, we will be learning about electricity and the components of an electrical circuits as well as circuit diagrams.

This will be the last week of the official buddy rota system with the YR children. We know the children will continue to be caring and considerate as well as great role models for the rest of the year.

On Wednesday 21 November (6B) and Wednesday 28 November (6PJ), will be visiting the Epsom and Ewell Council Chambers. We will be walking to the Chambers at approximately 9.00am and returning to school by lunchtime. This is part of our thrive experience for our theme 'Vote for Me'. The children will get to meet the Mayor and ask questions about the role they play within the community. We will need a parent volunteer to accompany the classes on the visit.
