Y4 Visit to the Gurjar Hindu Temple – Tuesday 19 March 2019

The children should wear smart full school uniform and will all need a packed lunch. It has been requested by the temple that no meat, fish or egg products are brought into the temple and we would be grateful if you could respect their wishes and consider this when making your child's packed lunch. Dairy products are acceptable. Please remember we are a nut free school. You are invited to make a voluntary contribution of £9.43 to cover the cost of the trip to the Temple.
