### Have you Remembered?

- Has your child brought their half term 'Wow Moment' sheet back to school?

A great big thank you to everyone that supported our PTA Fireworks evening, it was a wonderful display!

This week we will be exploring the story of the **Little Red Riding Hood** through a range of indoor and outdoor activities. The children are now expert storytellers and will, once again, act out the story and make story maps throughout the week. We will also be looking at **Remembrance Day** and the significance of poppies as we design our own.

Our new phonic sounds this week are '**h**', '**b**', and '**f**'. Having learnt so many letter sounds, the children are now starting to think of words that they can read and write independently such as 'peg, mat, and pin'. Your child may like to practise building words with their letter flashcards and/or writing words onto their whiteboard at home. Our new tricky word is '**no**'. So far we have learnt the tricky words: '**I, the, to and go**'. You could put these words around the house and see how quickly you can recognise them? Alternatively you could have a go at making 'rainbow tricky words' where you write the word once and then write the word on top using different colours. Learning to recognise words by sight will help build reading fluency.

In maths we will be focusing on the number **6**. As well as thinking about how to write the digit and count to 6, we will think very carefully about where we see 6, and what it is made of (i.e. six 'ones'; a three and a three etc). Can you find the number 6 when you are out shopping, or in your kitchen cupboard? This week's shape is the **cube** and we are looking a great deal at **two-part repeating patterns!**

**Show and Tell** will begin on **Thursday afternoon** (Thursday 8 November) with the theme of **family**. This week the **Squares** group from each class will have their turn. Your child's 'Show and Tell' may be

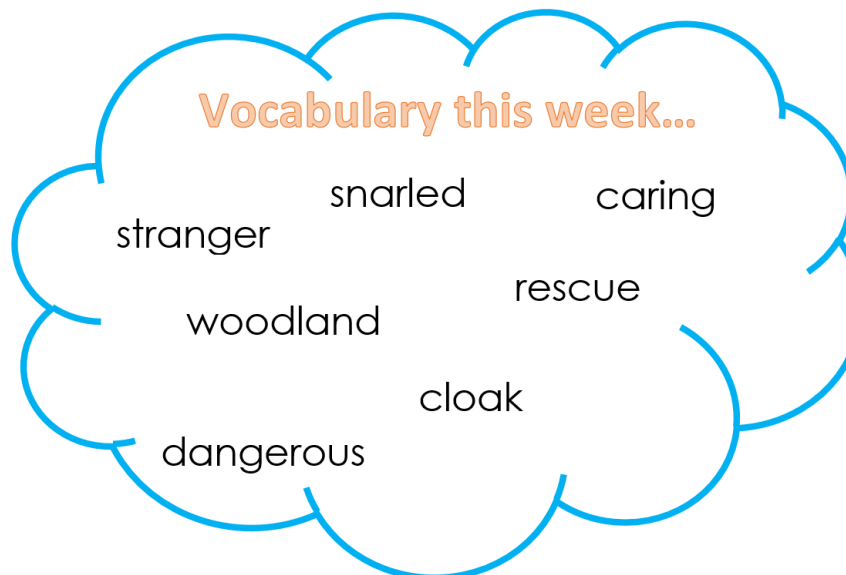
anything that they would like to share with the class, be it an object, a photo (feel free to email these), a drawing, souvenir or memento. You may want to add an explanatory note (or email your child's teacher) if you think that they might need a bit of support in explaining what they have brought in. Please make sure that they only bring their 'Show and Tell' item to school on Thursday morning, that it is name-labelled and isn't anything too fragile, precious or expensive. We cannot guarantee the safety of things that the children bring in to school!

**Golden Jumpers** will be given out this week. If your child comes home wearing a Golden Jumper please remember to return it in your child's book bag on the Friday. They will need their original blue school jumper/cardigan to wear on Friday.
