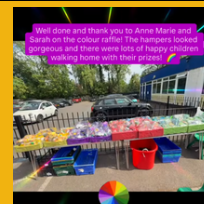

Long Term Spending Plans

Our Path of Adventures and the plans for the next adventure!



What would your child call this adventure?

Have a think over the summer and let Mrs Druce know in September.

Look out for the totaliser in the next PTA Bulletin so that you can see how the fundraising is going and what date we are aiming for.

Following the recent heat, a number of parents asked whether PTA funds earmarked for the Path of Adventures could instead be used to help keep classrooms cooler during periods of hot weather. Trustees discussed a range of options, including portable air conditioning units, fans and a permanent air conditioning system.

After careful consideration, portable air conditioning units are not currently a viable solution. In addition to significant purchase and running costs, there are challenges around effectiveness in classrooms, noise, limited storage space and the availability of suitable power sockets as well as windows for the exhaust hose. Large portable fans are not very effective in very high temperatures, when cooling is needed most, and simply circulate warm air rather than reduce room temperatures.

Trustees recognise the importance of ensuring children can learn comfortably during periods of extreme heat. While a permanent air conditioning system would likely be beyond the PTA's current budget, we will be exploring the costs further via a feasibility study to understand what would be required, the potential costs involved, and whether this may be a viable longer-term option for the school. We will keep parents/carers updated as this work progresses.

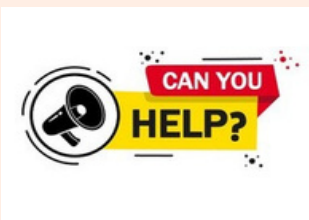
Second hand uniform sales
