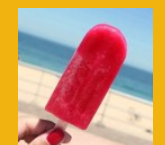
### Break the Rules Fundraising Day

As the weather heats up, some Y5 volunteers will be selling ice lollies outside of the school. Look out for posters and dates of the sales.

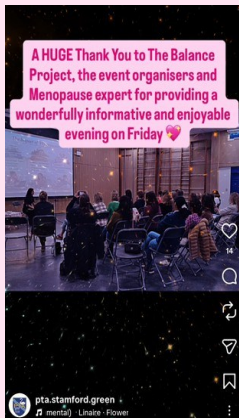
