Christmas shop & fundraising opportunities

Please help the PTA by boosting fundraising from your shopping online this Christmas or enquiring with your employer about any match-funding activities.

EASYFUNDRAISING

With the old Amazon Smile programme discontinued, easyfundraising is a simple and free way to raise money for our school whenever you shop online – and it costs you nothing extra: https://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/stamfordgreenprimary/ We already have 132 supporters, but with 400+ families at the school, there's plenty of room to grow – and every new supporter helps. So far we've raised £1,847.42 – a great start!

How it works

There are 8,000+ retailers on board – from supermarkets to fashion, homewares, travel and more.

When you shop, start at easyfundraising (via their website, app or browser "Donation Reminder") and then click through to your retailer as usual. After you checkout, the retailer gives a small "thank you" donation directly to our school — at no extra cost to you.

What you might raise

Donation amounts vary by retailer and by purchase. For example: John Lewis & Partners – up to 1.5% donation; Marks & Spencer – up to 12%; Argos – up to 4%; and many others.

EASYSEARCH

In addition, you can ditch Google, Yahoo! or Bing, in favour of: http://stamfordgreenprimary.easysearch.org.uk/

By using easysearch instead of Google or any other search engine, you can make a real difference. easysearch is

completely FREE and by making just 10 searches a day, you could raise around £20 a year for to your chosen cause.

EMPLOYER-LED MATCH-FUNDING

Lloyds Banking Group offers a match-funding scheme for employees to receive up to £1,000 per year for charitable donations and volunteering. Recent Lloyds Bank match-funding generated £500 for an hour's worth of a dad volunteering at the firework event. Investigate this with your employers as they may provide a similar benefit.

NON-UNIFORM DAYS

For all non-uniform events going forward, donations can be made in cash or via SumUp machine at the school gates, and you will also have the option to scan a QR code, displayed around school and in the newsletters.
