## PTA Update – Welcome to the Spring Term!

Welcome back to a brand-new term. We hope everyone enjoyed a restful break and has had a positive start to the year, despite the rather bleak weather! With the spring term now well underway and February half term just around the corner, there's plenty to look forward to.

We'd like to begin with a huge thank you to all the parents and carers who donated so generously on **Crazy Hair Day**. The creativity on display was fantastic, the children loved taking part, and your hard work certainly paid off. Events like this really highlight the strength of our school community, and your contributions play a vital role in helping the PTA fund those extra touches that make school life even more special.

There are lots of exciting events coming up over the next few months. We'll soon be launching sales of our **Wonka Chocolate Bars**, complete with exciting prizes. In March, we're looking forward to a fun and friendly **Quiz Night**, followed by the **Easter Challenge** and a **Disco** for the children. We'll also be running our ever-popular **Easter Raffle**, with some fantastic prizes to be won. Full details for all events will be shared over the coming weeks.

We're also pleased to share an update on PTA spending, following recent discussions and agreements about how funds will be used in the short, medium and long term to benefit all pupils.

Short-term spending, which has already been agreed, focuses on fun and seasonal extras that bring joy throughout the year. This includes items such as Christmas crackers, golden jumpers, ice lollies, sports day medals and other treats and activities that help create memorable moments for the children.

Looking to the medium term, Mrs Druce has proposed two exciting areas of focus. The first is booking **author visits in 2026**, with the aim of arranging up to two visits tailored to both younger and older age bands. These visits can be incredibly inspiring, encouraging a love of reading, writing and storytelling across the school. The second proposal is the **purchase of new books** for the school library, helping to refresh the collection and ensure pupils have access to engaging, high-quality texts that reflect a wide range of interests and reading levels.

Finally, our long-term spending, which has also been agreed previously, is dedicated to the Adventure Path extension and the next piece of play equipment. This is a significant investment that will enhance outdoor learning and play opportunities, providing lasting benefits for current and future pupils alike.

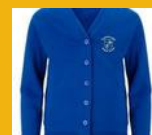

Thank you if you have been a previous member of the PTA 200 Club and massive congratulations to all our winners.

For those parents/carers new to the school, participants buy a number for £1.00 per month, payable as an £12.00 one-off payment per year (December 2025 to December 2026).

For those who participated last year, you now have the chance to renew your numbers or get new numbers. Every month there is a prize draw for a cash prize. 50% will go to the PTA and 50% will go in the prize pot for one number. Members may be any person aged over 18 with a connection to the school so whilst you are having your family chats over the weekend, why not spread the word and get them involved. ## **PTA 200 Club Rules**

### **Aims**

- The purpose of the 200 Club is to raise money for the PTA who support projects to enrich school life for the children.
- Money raised will go into the PTA bank account and will be used to fund extra resources, activities and opportunities for the children.
- The 200 Club shall not be limited to 200 members. The more numbers/shares we sell, the bigger the prizes!

### **Rules**

- 1.The Stamford Green PTA 200 Club will operate as a Small Society Lottery as defined by the Gambling Act 2005.
- 2.For a cost of £1.00 per month (i.e. per draw), payable as £12.00 per year, a member is allocated a number. Payments of £12.00 must be made by cash, debit card or through PTA events website and will be paid into the PTA's bank account. Only numbers that are fully paid will be entered into the draw. This number will remain the member's.
- 4.Monthly draws will be held between December 2025 and December 2026.
- 5.A list of all members in the 200 Club will be kept by a nominated member of the PTA.
- 6.A draw will be made every month with a single prize of 50% of the monthly money received for the 200 Club.
- 7.Participants must be over 18 but may be any person with a connection to the school.
- 8.There is no limit to the number of entrants per household.
- 9.Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 10.The draw shall be made by a member of staff and witnessed. Draws will be done on the last Friday of the month (or before if it falls during a holiday).
- 12.Prize winners will be notified and payment made will be made as soon as possible. Prize money that remains uncollected for 3 months shall be repaid to the PTA 200 Club fund.
- 13.The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the PTA Instagram and in the PTA Bulletin.
- 14.The 200 Club will be run by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Trustees is final.

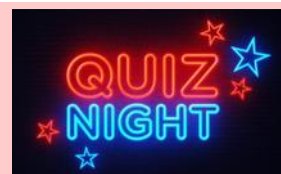
