Community Lettings

Stamford Green Primary School has a number of facilities for clubs and individuals to hire including catering facilities.

Facilities are for hire throughout the year for both evenings and weekends.

Individual bookings for a one off event or block bookings are available and are accepted on receipt of a signed copy of the school's Terms and Conditions of hire and a copy of a Public Liability Insurance cover (if available). Payment for hire is made in advance, and normally requested by invoice.

Please note, school events will take priority over external bookings. However, where a booking coincides with school events, clubs/individuals will be given as much notice as possible, and we will endeavour to make alternative arrangements to minimize any inconvenience.
