YR Visit to British Wildlife Centre Monday 26 June 2023

As part of our thrive experiences, we are very excited to be able to visit The British Wildlife Centre with the Reception children this year! This trip has changed from Godstone Farm because the children will get a closer experience with the animals and we also have the cente to ourselves. The visit will be a valuable contribution to our learning this term, and promises to be an exciting day! If you haven't yet paid and given consent for the Reception Thrive Experiences and would like to make your voluntary contribution, please do so via Scopay.

Children should come to school at the usual time as we will leave at approximately 9.15am and should be back at school by 2.55pm, although this is dependent on traffic.

Children should wear smart school uniform. Depending on the weather at the time, a waterproof jacket or a sunhat will also be needed. In the case of hot weather please ensure your child is wearing sun cream when they come to school.

The children will need a packed lunch. If your child usually has a school meal on the day they visit the British Wildlife Centre it will be provided by the school kitchen. If you wish to send additional snacks to supplement the school lunch then you are most welcome but please respect that we are a nut-free school and no fizzy drinks are permitted. Please send your child's lunch, sunhat, raincoat and water bottle in a small rucksack so that they can keep all of their belongings together. Please make sure that everything they bring, including the rucksack is labelled clearly with your child's name.

Last December, you were invited to pay £28.00 for the Reception Thrive Experiences and were asked to log in to Scopay and go to the trip section, tick the permission box and pay the voluntary contribution of £28.00. The deadline for payment was 1 December 2022. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed trip will not take place if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the costs.

We are looking for parent helpers to join us, to keep the children safe and have fun on the day. If you are able to volunteer then please email via <u>parents@stamford-green.surrey.sch.uk</u> stating your child's name and class. We will confirm if you are required to assist via a sticker in your child's Learning Journal. Please be aware that we have limited spaces on our coaches so if you do volunteer to help for the day, you may need to make your own way to and from the venue. We will confirm with those volunteers nearer to the time
