 Grey skirt or pinafore (no denim or cord): Length on or below the knee Worn with grey tights or plain grey socks, ankle length or below the knee (no trainer socks) 	Generic
 Summer dress or playsuit – royal blue check: Optional in warmer weather Length on or below the knee Worn with plain white socks, ankle length or below the knee (no trainer socks or tights) 	Generic
Appropriate black shoes: No heels, open toes, strappy sandals, crocs, jelly shoes, boots or trainers Please, no laces until your child can tie them independently	Generic

Personal Appearance		
Watches	Inexpensive, plain analogue watches may be worn and are the child's responsibility but must be removed for PE lessons	
Jewellery	 No jewellery is permitted except: Plain stud earrings, which must be removed by your child for PE lessons / sporting activities Religious jewellery – please speak to your child's class teacher 	
Heads	 Religious headwear must be royal blue or black No other headwear may be worn inside 	
Make-up	Make-up is not permitted	
Nail varnish	Nail varnish is not permitted	
Hair	 Hair should be neat, tidy and appropriate for a school environment, as defined by the school Hair longer than shoulder length, should be tied back Fringes should not obstruct vision Hair bands, Alice bands and clips may be used Any hair accessories must be plain and in school colours (royal blue, white, grey or black) No flowers, scarves or large bows may be worn Hair colouring, extreme styles and styling products are not permitted Shaved lines or patterns in hair or eyebrows are not permitted 	

The decision about what is and what is not acceptable will always remain with the school.
