New learning space with step free access from hall to provide a quiet space for smaller groups which will benefit children with anxiety and / or sensory overload.	Remove sink and kitchen cabinets.  Furniture to be re-purposed from bulge class.	£2,000	April 2024	
Nursery outdoor learning area will have a fixed boundary creating separation of school access point and children.	Explore boundary options – fixed vs movable fencing.	£500	September 2024	

Hall will be accessible for all with improved AV equipment, seating, lighting, flooring and storage.	AV equipment – consider inclusion of hearing loop, improved projection equipment and necessary adjustments to reduce glare for visual impairment.	£50,000	September 2024	
	Flooring to be designed to meet the needs of a multi-use area (sports, assembly and dining hall) whilst reducing noise distraction.	£20,000	September 2024	
	Check accessibility of Hall PE equipment and storage.	£300	September 2024	
Path of Adventures to include accessible play equipment to provide a sensory experience for children.	Consider area of different surfaces (rubber, wood chip, sand, gravel etc.)	£2000	September 2026
