White polo shirt	Generic for YN only
Royal blue nursery sweatshirt	Logo
<ul> <li>Black trousers, shorts, skirts, leggings, tracksuit bottoms (no denim, cord):</li> <li>Skirts should be worn with black tights and only if your child can go to the toilet independently when wearing them</li> <li>Trousers, shorts, leggings and tracksuit bottoms should be worn with black ankle socks</li> </ul>	Generic
<ul> <li>Appropriate trainers or shoes:</li> <li>No heels, open toes, strappy sandals, crocs, jelly shoes, boots or trainers</li> <li>Please, no laces until your child can tie them independently</li> </ul>	Generic

Watches	No watches are permitted	
Jewellery	<ul> <li>No jewellery is permitted except:</li> <li>Plain stud earrings, which must be removed by your child for PE lessons / sporting activities</li> <li>Religious jewellery – please speak to your child's class teacher</li> </ul>	
Heads	<ul> <li>Religious headwear must be royal blue or black</li> <li>No other headwear may be worn inside</li> </ul>	
Nail varnish	Nail varnish is not permitted	
Hair	<ul> <li>Hair should be neat, tidy and appropriate for a school environment, as defined by the nursery/school</li> <li>Hair longer than shoulder length, should be tied back</li> <li>Fringes should not obstruct vision</li> <li>Hair bands, Alice bands and clips may be used</li> <li>Any hair accessories should be plain and in school colours (royal blue, white, grey or black)</li> <li>No flowers, scarves or large bows may be worn</li> <li>Hair colouring, extreme styles and styling products are not permitted</li> <li>Shaved lines or patterns in hair or eyebrows are not permitted</li> </ul>	

The decision about what is and what is not acceptable will always remain with the nursery/school.
