Royal blue nursery sweatshirt 	Logo
Black trousers, shorts, skirts, leggings, tracksuit bottoms (no denim, cord): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skirts should be worn with black tights and only if your child can go to the toilet independently when wearing them • Trousers, shorts, leggings and tracksuit bottoms should be worn with black ankle socks 	Generic
Appropriate trainers or shoes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No heels, open toes, strappy sandals, crocs, jelly shoes, boots or trainers • Please, no laces until your child can tie them independently 	Generic

Personal Appearance	
Watches	No watches are permitted
Jewellery	No jewellery is permitted except: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plain stud earrings, which must be removed by your child for PE lessons / sporting activities • Religious jewellery – please speak to your child's class teacher
Heads	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Religious headwear must be royal blue or black • No other headwear may be worn inside
Nail varnish	Nail varnish is not permitted
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair should be neat, tidy and appropriate for a school environment, as defined by the nursery/school • Hair longer than shoulder length, should be tied back • Fringes should not obstruct vision • Hair bands, Alice bands and clips may be used • Any hair accessories should be plain and in school colours (royal blue, white, grey or black) • No flowers, scarves or large bows may be worn • Hair colouring, extreme styles and styling products are not permitted • Shaved lines or patterns in hair or eyebrows are not permitted

The decision about what is and what is not acceptable will always remain with the nursery/school.
