You can help at home by getting them to put their Book Bags and belongings away, and then getting them to get themselves ready for nursery.

## Reminders for you:

### Sickness

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school or nursery when they're unwell.

This [link](#) helps you decide.

e.g. children with diarrhoea or vomiting should stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours).  
If you do keep your child at home, you must report the absence using the link on our [Website](#) by 8.00am on the day of absence.

### Calpol

If your child needs Calpol during the school day for an on-going illness, please could you bring a bottle into school and fill in the Google [Form](#) online.

We have a small supply for emergencies only.

### School Lunches

From 1 October 2023 the cost of a school lunch will increase to £2.70. This is the first increase in the cost of a school lunch for many years and we have worked with Accent to keep the rise to a minimum and ensure that the cost is in line with that charged by other local schools.



**Is your child starting school in September 2024?**

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 you will need to apply for a school place. You can apply between **30 October 2023 and 15 January 2024**.

Applying on time will give your child the best chance of getting one of your preferred schools.
