Children under the age of 1 will be admitted for free. Please purchase a 'sibling ticket' for any siblings who would like to join the event.

Places purchased in advance will be emailed via the PTA Events system to you or can be downloaded via your orders in your PTA Events Account. On the day please bring a print out of your 'tickets' or have them available to view on your phone. All digital tickets will be checked at the gate, there will be no entry without a ticket. Should you wish to pay on the day, tickets will be available via contactless payment and the cost of entry will be as follows: Adult £2.50 and Children £3.50.
