Y6 Visit to Tate Britain and Houses of Parliament 6L – Monday 20 November 2023 6DA – Monday 27 November 2023 6B – Tuesday 9 January 2024

We have arranged for our Year 6 pupils to visit the Tate Britain and Houses of Parliament. We will be travelling by train from Epsom station, leaving school around **9.00am** and will be returning at approximately **6.20pm**. Please note this late end to the school day is due to the restricted times of visits to the Houses of Parliament. The children should be wearing full school uniform and school shoes. Your child will need their water bottle and a packed lunch for the trip, please remember we are a nut free school – if your child has a school dinner booked for the day of their class's trip, then the kitchen will provide a packed lunch. Due to our late return, you may like to pack a more generous lunch than usual and a small extra snack for the journey home.

Once we arrive at Vauxhall station, we will be walking to the Tate Britain, where we will spend the first part of the day. We are looking forward to seeing art by many of Britain's greatest artists, from Tudor times to the present day. We will be keeping a special look out for Bridget Riley, who we have been studying this term. In the afternoon, we will be walking to the Houses of Parliament for a guided tour and a workshop on how the UK Parliament turns an idea into a law. The children will find out about how a bill passes through the House of Commons and the House of Lords. Our session is due to end at **4.45pm (6L & 6DA) or 4.25pm (6B)**. Following the session, we will be returning to school by train from Waterloo station. We expect to be back at school at approximately **6.20pm** but will keep you updated about any delays via the school's website or X feed. 6B may return slightly earlier due to their earlier time slot at the Houses of Parliament so please look at the school's website or X feed.

If you would like your child to take part in this trip you will need to log into Scopay and go to the trip section, tick the consent box and pay the voluntary contribution of £7.85 by Monday 30 October to cover the cost of train travel. We confirm that the voluntary contribution represents our estimate of the costs of providing this activity shared equally amongst all pupils. As the resources of the school are limited, the proposed trip will not be viable if there are insufficient voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the trip. If you have any problems using the online payment system, Scopay, please contact the school office. For families in receipt of Pupil Premium/Free School Meals, the premium will cover the cost of your child attending so please just tick the consent box so they can attend.
