Reception Weekly Information - w/b 30.10.23

Parent/Carer Teacher consultations for those who have booked are this Wednesday 1 November 3.30-6.30pm. Please remember no children, including siblings, should come to school for this event.

Please ensure that you remove earrings on the morning of PE day as your child will not be allowed to participate if wearing them and we are not able to do this for them.

If possible, please name your child's fruit so that it can easily be recognised at snack time.

We hope you had a fun and relaxing half term break. We are all looking forward to the second half of term, which promises to be full of exciting learning opportunities for the children in Reception.

We look forward to seeing you at the Parent/Carer and Teacher Consultations at school this week or next. This is a chance to have a conversation with your child's teacher about how they have settled into Reception, the progress they have made so far and how you can support them with their learning and development. The children's books and folders will be available in the classrooms for you to look at before or after your appointment in the Studio, which is just down the corridor from the Reception classrooms.

As mentioned in the <u>letter</u>, no children, including siblings, will be allowed to come into school for Parent/Carer and Teacher Consultations. We do not have capacity to care for children during the adults only appointments – many parents help each other out with reciprocal arrangements for child care. In addition, if your child attends Sunset please note that the dismissal arrangements remain the same as normal.



In the coming weeks and months, we will be learning about some of the different things that people celebrate. As part of this we would love to hear about your family's special faith and cultural celebrations. If you celebrate Diwali and would be able to come and talk to the children about what makes Diwali special, or if you have some photos or items that you could share for us to look at please email your child's teacher using the parents' <u>email</u>.

If you have a child who is of pre-school age, you might be interested to know that the next Come and Play session will be happening on Thursday 9 November 9.00am – 10.30am. This is a free play session which is open to pre-school aged children of all ages with their parents/carers. It is a

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

In maths, we will be focusing on the number **6**. As well as thinking about how to write the digit and how to count to 6 or count six objects, we will think carefully about where and how we might see 6 and what parts it is made of (i.e. six 'ones'; a four and a two etc). Can you find the number 6 when you are out shopping, or whilst looking in your kitchen cupboard? What does it look like? Perhaps you can see two threes or a five and a one?

Show and tell is an opportunity for each child to share something special with their class practicing their speaking skills.
