Reading Packs

Thank you for continuing to support your child at home with their reading. Please record any reading you do together including books you share with them at bedtime. Your child's pack should be kept together in their book bag so that we can change their books. Friday is usually book changing day in Reception, so look out for new reading materials each week. If they have books missing on the changeover day you will receive a yellow slip detailing the missing contents and we may not be able to give your child their new reading materials until they have returned the previous set so that we can keep track of our reading resources.

We are certain you have probably heard your child singing Christmas songs in preparation for our end of term performances of 'Reception's First Christmas Songs' which will take place during the last week of term. Tickets are not limited for this show. You can invite other wider family members if they would like to come along – unlike lots of other school performances, where places are usually restricted.

For the show we will ask children to wear a festive top instead of their normal school jumper or cardigan. This could be a traditional 'Christmas Jumper' or it might be a jumper or top in a Christmassy colour – red, green, white or sparkly! Please could we ask you to kindly send them into school (with their name clearly labelled) on Friday 8 or Monday 12 December at the very latest. We aren't asking for them any sooner than that because, as you will have seen in Dates for Diaries, next Thursday, 7 December, is Christmas jumper day for the whole school.

A plea

If your child has borrowed our school clothing, such as underwear and socks, please return them to Reception as soon as possible – our supply is running very low. On that note, if you have any spare boys' underwear or socks aged 4-5, we would be very grateful for donations. Thank you.

A quick reminder that bottles for school should be plastic and have a sports cap – as per the school uniform and equipment list. If your child's bottle allows water to flow freely from it when it is lying on its side, or if the lid must be completely removed in order to drink from it, it isn't suitable for school. Father Christmas sometimes kindly leaves lovely new school water bottles in children's stockings, so if you see him in the run up to Christmas, perhaps you could pass on the message to him too?

We are feeling jolly in Reception now that Christmas is fast approaching. This week the children will learn about the Christmas story and will enjoy lots of festive activities! We will be practicing singing our Christmas songs in preparation for our Christmas singing performances.

This week's concept word is: Smooth


Help your child at home: look around the house for as many smooth things as you can find.

Reading

Thank you for using your child's phonics pack at home to help them with their reading. We can see from what you have written in the Learning Journals and what the children have told us that you have been very busy! It is lovely to see how excited the children are to share their learning with you at home. These few minutes of practice each day are vital to their progress in reading – it's super to see the children growing in confidence as a result.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on the number 10. We will continue to develop our understanding of parts and wholes (Which numbers go together to make up ten?). Can you find number 10 anywhere? Can you represent the number 10? Perhaps you know a song which uses the numbers to 10? Can you find 10 objects in 10 seconds?

This week (Thursday 30 November) the Rectangles group from each class will have their turn at Show and Tell and the theme is family. Show and Tell is an opportunity for each child to share something special with their class practising their speaking skills. The rest of the class practise their listening skills and have the chance to ask questions too. Your child might want to share a picture or drawing of their family to talk about.
